Norco IMC invites you to take a look back to December 3, 1993 when Norco College broke ground on Phase II.

Two new buildings were to be built as part of the master plan of development.

In the three years since the college had opened, student enrollment growth was at such a pace that it was holding classes off-site to accommodate its 4,000 students.

Plans called for a new applied technology building and library with an outdoor amphitheater that added 52,000 square feet to the campus.

Members from the RCCD Board of Trustees and Norco City Council were on hand to assist Norco Interim Provost Dr. Brenda Davis break ground.

Construction was scheduled to be completed by March 1995 and would add 17 classrooms to the college.
