Norco IMC invites you to take a look back to November 17, 1995 at Norco College's Phase II Ribbon Cutting & Dedication.

The ceremony was held to officially welcome students, faculty, staff, and the community to the newly expanded campus. Phase II construction, which was completed in the previous spring, consisted of a new library, amphitheater, Applied Technology building, expanded parking spaces, and athletic fields. With the new facilities, Norco College added 10,000 square feet of library space as well as 31,000 square feet of classroom and office space in the Applied Technology building to accomodate its growing student population.

The ribbon cutting took place followed by the dedication of the library, hereafter known as the Wilfred J. Airey Library, named after former Board of Trustee member Dr. Wilfred Airey. Guests were also treated to a campus tour.
