





Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) 2015-2016

The courses listed below are those that Norco College is offering during the WINTER 2016 term that can fulfill lower division transfer requirements following the IGETC pattern.

There are other courses that can fulfill these requirements; for a complete list of options, please see the Norco College Catalog.

Once completed, the Intersegmental General Education (IGETC) will permit a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC) system generally without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower winds or general education courses. Some of the UC campuses do not accommend (IGETC) or certain majors (i.e. Engineering, Sciences).

It is recommended that all students with the goal of transfer to a 4-year university develop a Student Educational Plan (SEP). A Norco College courselor can assist you in developing a SEP for your specific goals.

Transfer Students will receive IGETC certification after completing all of the subject areas below with a minimum "C" grade or better.


