Some of the UC campuses do not accept or recommend IGETC for certain majors (i.e. Engineering, Sciences). It is recommended that all students with the goal of transfer to a 4-year university develop a Student Educational Plan (SEP). A Norco College counselor can assist you in developing a SEP for your specific goals. Transfer Students will receive IGETC certification after completing all of the subject areas below with a minimum "C" grade or better.

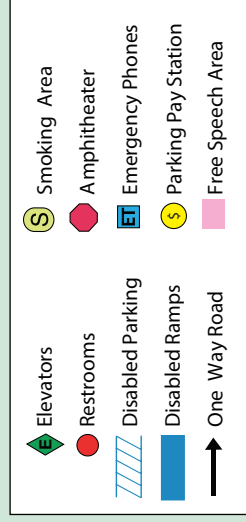
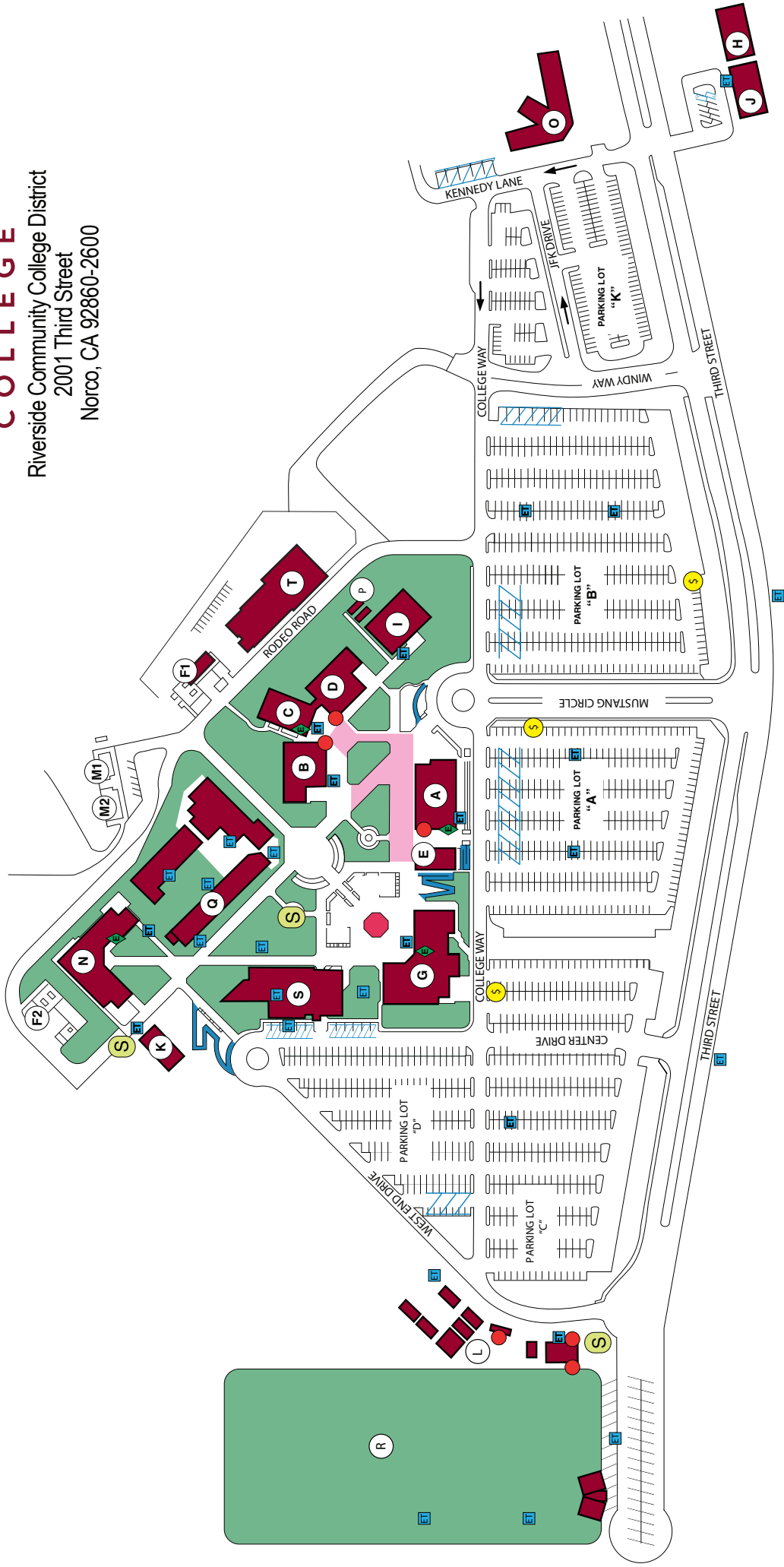
