Dr. Edwin Romero states that the Athletics budget is a just proposal for the upcoming school year. ASNC makes amendments to Athletics budget. A line item for LGBTQIA+ Events (92306) has been created and the line item for Textbook Loaner Project (92214) was reduced. An account number for ICC Promotions was added, which is 92117. Also added a Men of Color Program line item (92118) for \$10,000. Made changes to other line items too.

Dr. Edwin Romero states that there have only been seven responses for the survey so far. Dr. Edwin Romero states that there's four questions on the survey and that it is straightforward. The Associated Students take the ASNC survey during this meeting. Dr. Romero wants to know what areas ASNC can improve in. With the responses that Dr. Romero has received thus far, he states that ASNC members generally feel like they improved their leadership skills, made an impact, made new friends, and more. Criticisms that Dr. Romero sees from the survey is that there weren't many bonding activities, not enough accountability taken from members who didn't do as much work as they should have, and more. Dr. Edwin Romero states that ASNC can no longer be active during the summer and winter, so retreats will have to occur during the spring and fall semesters.
