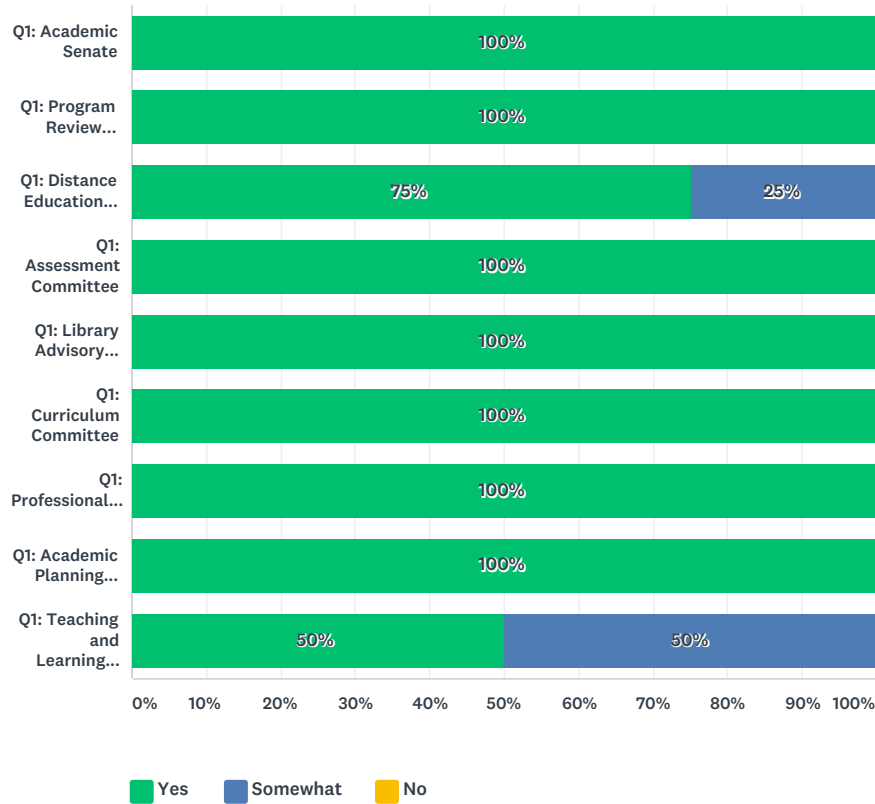


Q2 Do you feel you have a clear understanding of the structure and purpose of this committee?

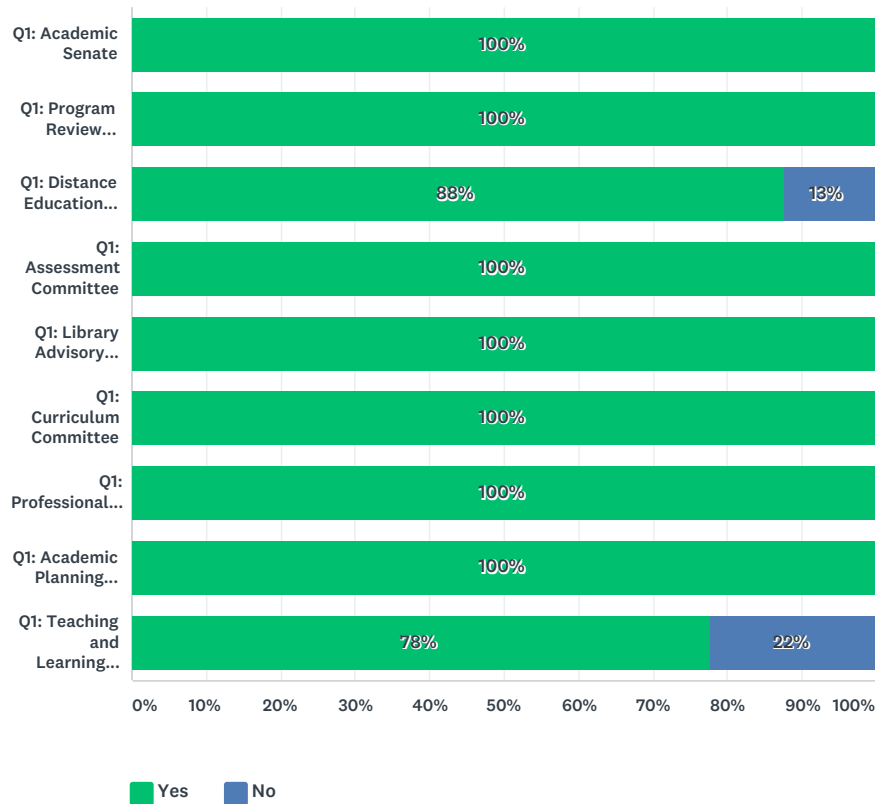

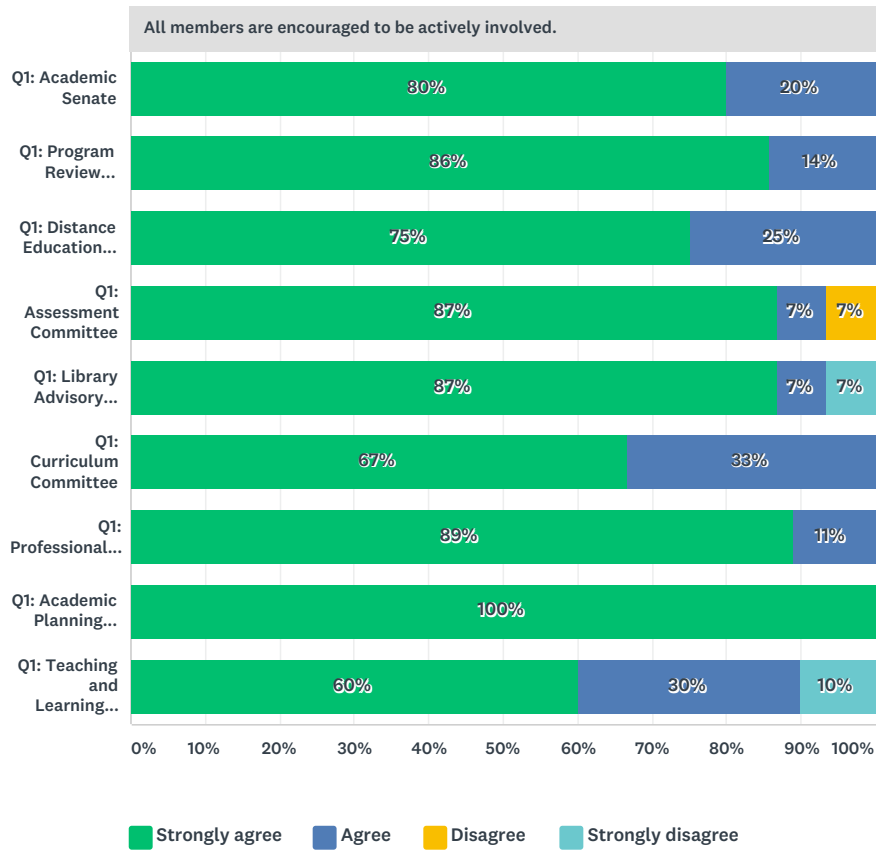

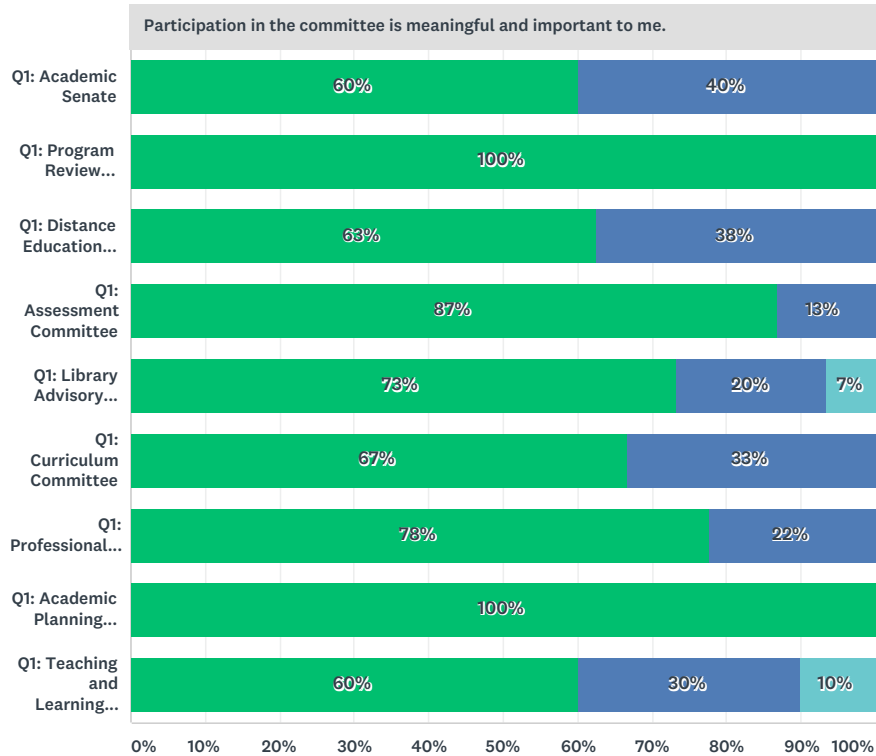

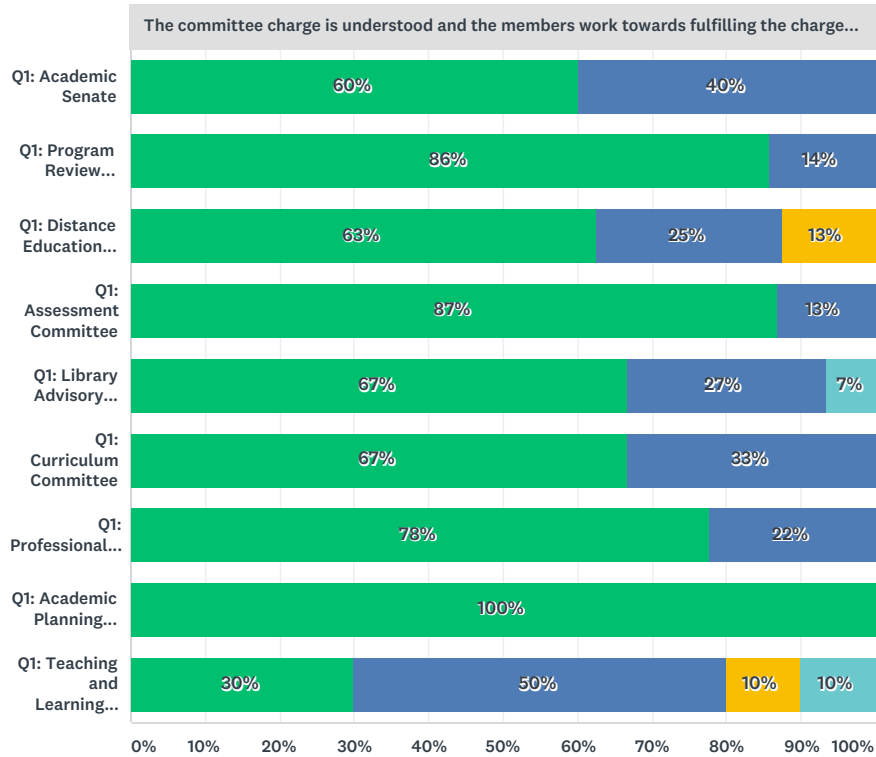

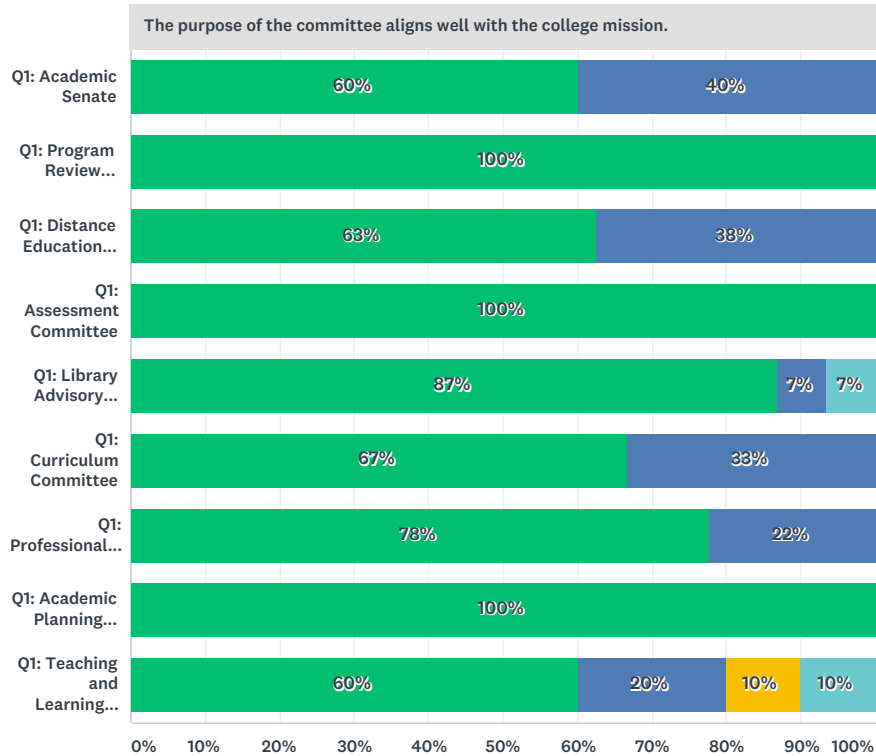

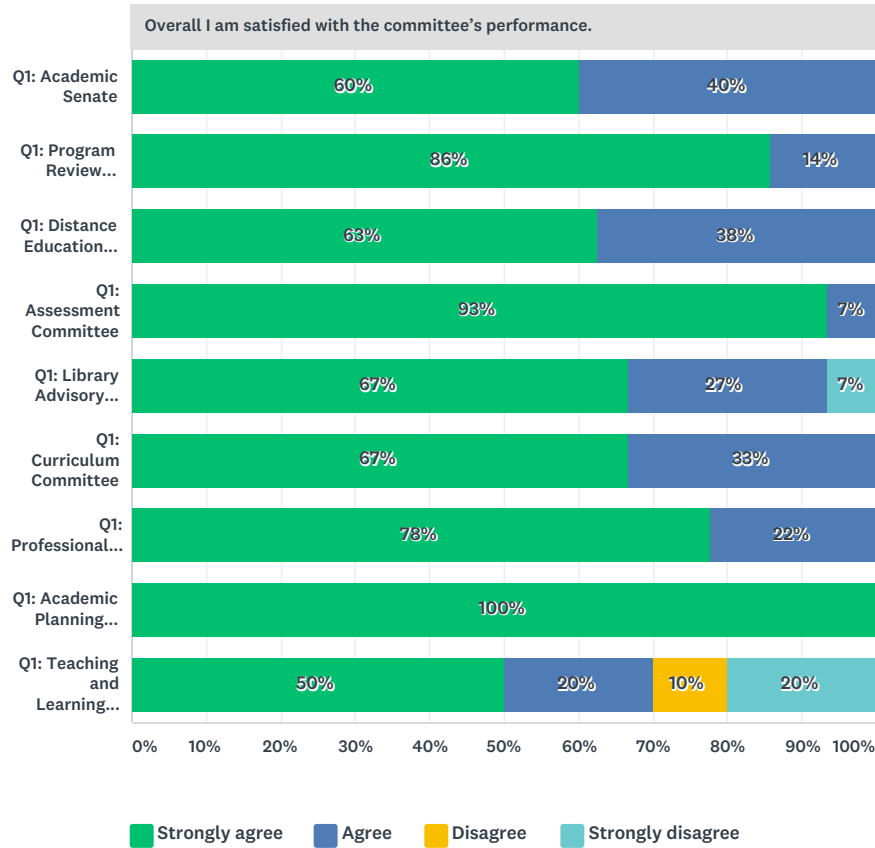
