Norco IMC invites you to take a look back to the Phase II construction of the Library, Applied Technology building, and Amphitheater.

Scheduled to be completed in the Spring of 1995, Norco College prepared to add 31,000 square feet of classroom and office space in a project estimated to cost 8.7 million.

The two-story **Applied Technology** building featured "computerized laboratories" for drafting technology students. The new Amphitheater was built to seat 700. A clocktower and an open-beam ceiling with skylights were included in the construction of the Libray. Also included in the phase was a new parking lot that added 700 parking spaces.

The new buildings included energy efficiency and earthquake safety features as well as access systems for the disabled.
