Norco IMC invites you to take a look back to May 1994, when Dr. Brenda Davis was officially named Provost of Norco College.

Brenda Davis had already been serving as the Interim Provost since July 1993. At that time, Dr. Marie Pepicello, the first Provost for Norco College, had resigned to accept a position in Arizona. Dr. Davis stepped up as Provost and would remain in that position for twelve years.

In 2006, the campus, known at that time as RCC Norco Campus, became Norco College and Brenda Davis its first president.

During her presidency, numerous projects were planned and completed, including the Library, Applied Technology, Industrial Technology, and the Center for Student Success (which later would be named in honor of Dr. Davis).

Dr. Davis retired in June 2011. She made innumerable contributions to the college through her hard work and spirit.
