
Greetings, Norco College,

Thank you to the 125 faculty who have completed the survey so far. Based on the results of the survey, faculty now have the option to invite another instructor as a visitor in their Canvas shell. Here's how it works:

• Email your chair to let them know you have added another instructor. The <u>Observer</u> <u>or Co-Teacher / Mentor</u> form is located on our forms page <u>https://www.rccd.edu/admin/ed_services/de/Pages/forms.aspx</u>. This will authenticate the requestor with their login and provide security as a means for granting permission (Hat Tip Melissa Bader:).

The Library & Learning Resource Center (LRC) continues to make progress expanding online support services for our students:

- Norco College librarians are available <u>online via chat</u> during regular library hours: Monday-Thursday 7:30am-8pm; Friday 7:30am-4pm; Saturday 9am-2pm.
- Outside of regular library hours, you may <u>chat with a librarian</u> 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
- Some textbooks and course materials are available <u>online</u>.

- Make an <u>appointment with a tutor</u>. Drop in tutoring is available via <u>ZOOM</u>. Online tutoring is available via <u>NetTutor</u>.

STUDENT SERVICES

- **Commencement Student Survey Underway**: In an effort to gain feedback from potential graduates, a survey was sent to 2,207 eligible graduates for 2020 to get their input. We are exploring <u>virtual commencement</u> for the class of 2020, and giving graduates the option to join the class of 2021 for a traditional commencement ceremony.
- **Grab n Go Bags:** Settlement House will now be able to provide our students with a bag of groceries worth \$60-75 once a week. Students will need to show their Norco College Student ID to access this service.
