AHS-6 (36180) ART APPRECIATION

An introductory course for the non-art major. The creative process and the diversity of style, technique and media, evident in various art forms throughout history and culture. - UC/CSU 3 Units

MUS-19 (36177) MUSIC APPRECIATION

A broad survey of music in the Western world, including terminology for describing musical elements, forms, and styles. Organized to acquaint students with the roles of music and musicians in society and with representative musical selections through listening. UC/CSU 3 Units

QUI-47 (36044) CAREER EXPLORATION & LIFE PLANNING

In depth career and life planning: Topics include extensive exploration of one's values, interests and abilities; life problem-solving and self-management skills; adult development theory and the changes that occur over the life span; self-assessment including identifying one's skills and matching personality with work. An intensive career investigation; decision making, goal setting and job search strategies, as well as resume writing and interviewing skills will also be addressed. This course is designed to assist those students considering the transition of a career change or undecided about the selection of a college major. 3 Units

ENG-1A (36202) ENGLISH COMPOSITION

Emphasizes skills in critical reading, and writing, including research. Integrated reading and writing assignments respond to various rhetorical situations. Students will produce a minimum of 7500 words of assessed writing. Classroom instruction integrates writing lab activities. UC/CSU 4 Units.
