Santiago Vega Sr. (left), is a Marine Corps veteran (same MOS as Jr.) When Mr. Vega, who owns a successful lighting business, learned that he could also qualify for 17 units for his military training, he decided to pursue an AA in Social and Behavioral Sciences and is well on his way to completion.

Josie Vega (right), Wife, Mother, Business Partner. Inspired to also broaden her opportunities, Mrs. Vega decided to add a college degree to her career and is now working full-time toward a Sociology AS.

CCC CPL Mandate

Mandate: Assessment of Prior Learning

Title 5 55050 Item (j) ...a student, upon completion of their educational plan...shall be referred to the college's appropriate authority for assessment of prior learning if the student is a veteran or an active-duty member of the armed forces, holds industry-recognized credentials, or requests credit for a course based on their prior learning.

CCC CPL Mandate

Mandate: Assessment of Prior Learning

Title 5 55050 Item (k) ...shall offer students an **opportunity to accept, decline, or appeal** decisions related to the award of credit, and in cases of credit by exam.

Title V Section 55050 (d) Clarification Needed

(d) Credit may be awarded...only for individually identified courses...and only for a course listed in the catalog of the community college. Colleges shall consider the credit recommendations of the American Council on Education pursuant to Education Code section 66025.71. Upon a student's demonstration of sufficient mastery through an examination or assessment, an award of credit should be made, if possible, to California Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum, California State University General Education Breadth, and local community college general education requirements or requirements for a student's chosen program. Award of credit may be made to electives for students who do not require additional general education or program credits to meet their goals.

Title V Clarification (pending approval)

When CPL is awarded for individually identified college courses, the courses shall be listed in the college catalog. Credit shall be applied as appropriate to the California Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum, California State University General Education Breadth, and local community college general education requirements, or requirements for a student's chosen program (**Note: What about CalGETC?**). When the college is not able to award course credit based on the catalog, credit may be applied to general education requirements, major requirements, or electives needed to meet graduation requirements.

RCCD Credit for Prior Learning Assessment Petition

- Credit for Prior Learning Evaluation Information and Guidelines:
- The student must be currently enrolled, in good standing in the district, and have completed at least 12 units in the district, or 50% of the certificate coursework at RCCD.
- The student is not currently enrolled in the course to be considered or challenged.
- Credit for Prior learning does not supersede 50% of certificate coursework requirement for the district. 50% of the coursework for any certificate pattern must be completed at any of the colleges within Riverside Community College District.
- The course is listed in a current college catalog of either Riverside City College, Norco College, or Moreno Valley College.
- Credit for prior learning may not be available for all course offerings and is contingent upon discipline curricular decisions as approved by the Office of Academic Affairs.

Please Note: CPL issued by Riverside Community College District is not currently recognized by the UC system. Please speak with a counselor to determine if CPL review process is beneficial to your specific academic goals.

- We award college credit for prior learning (CPL) based on your JST credit recommendations, program of study, and transfer destination. ☐ PRIORITY REGISTRATION

- Veteran students are eligible for a total of four years of priority registration to be used within fifteen years after being discharged from active duty. To determine eligibility, submit a copy of your DD214 (Member 4 form) to the Veterans Resource Center via email at veterans.services@norccollege.edu.

☐ REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- If you were eligible for priority registration and missed registration, you will need to register for classes on your regular assigned date. Registration for classes will take place via WebAdvisor/EduNav on your registration date. It is mandatory that you communicate to Veterans Resource Center of any changes in your enrollment after you have received your benefits.

☐ VETERANS INTENT & STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY (VISoR)

- Veteran and dependent students utilizing VA benefits for the term are required to turn in a Veterans Intent & Statement of Responsibility (VISoR) form. 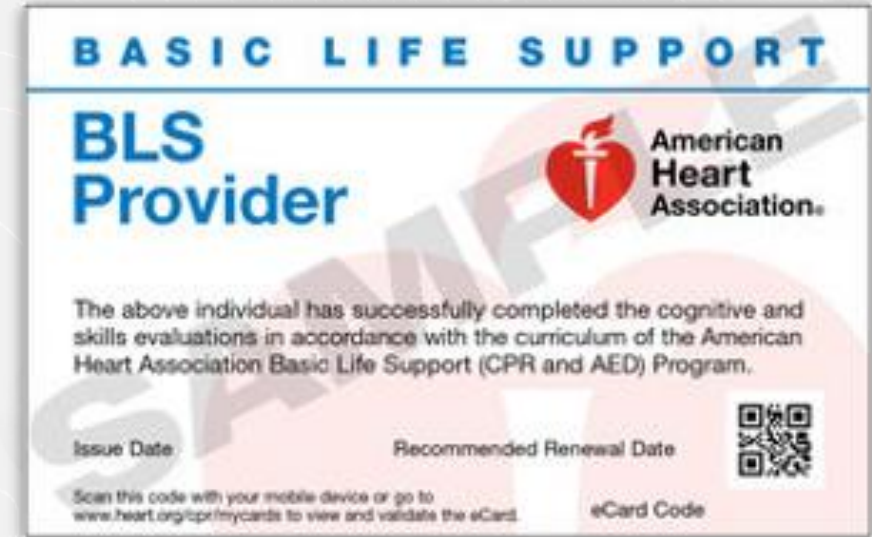

 4. Describe the signs and symptoms associated with common medical emergencies and explain the first aid care that is needed.



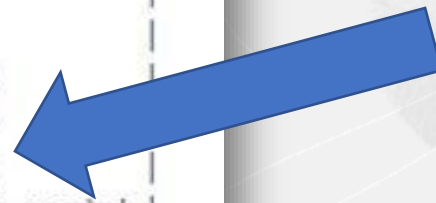

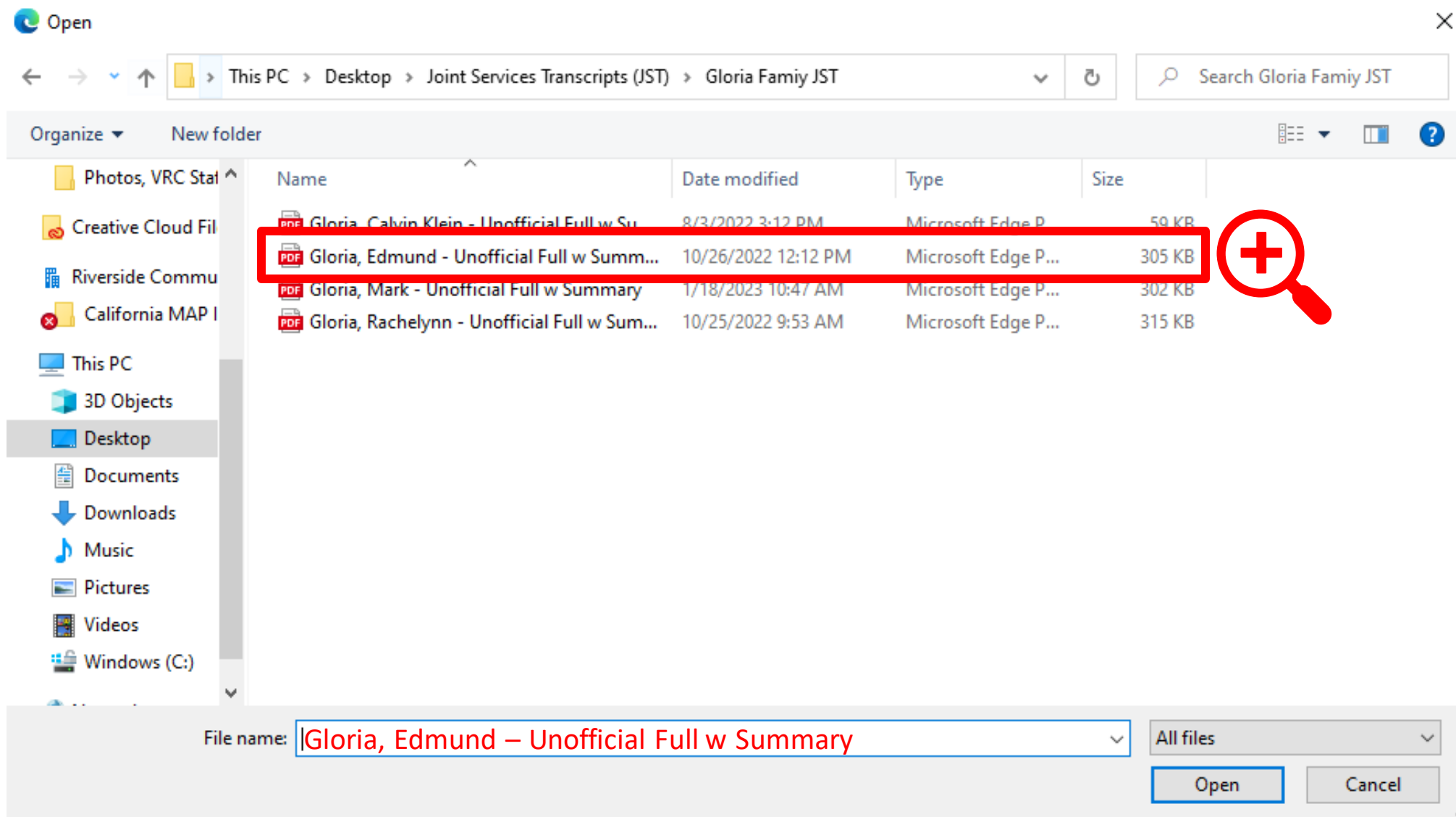

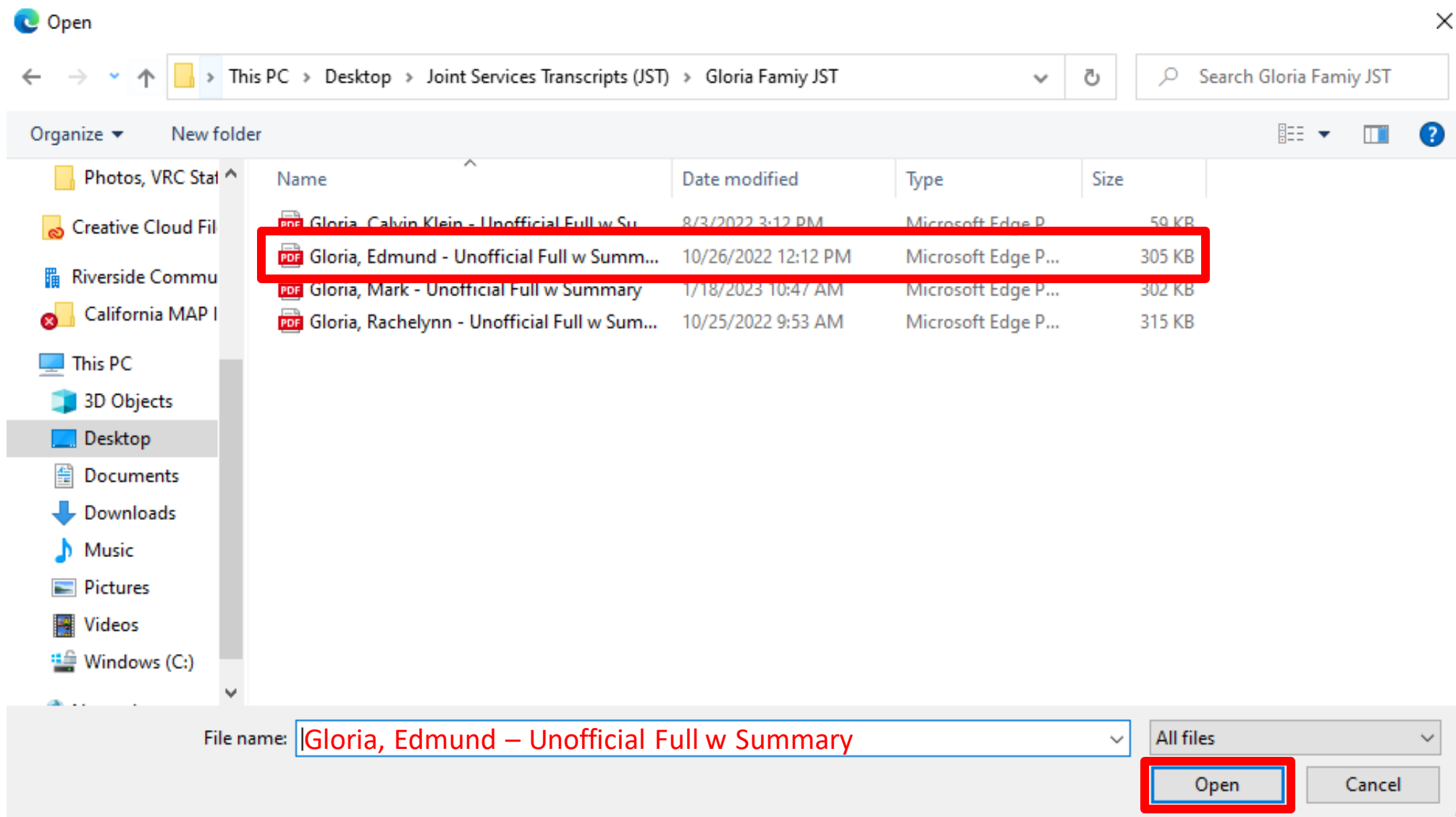
