Student Services Program Review Data

Norco College

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The purpose of this report is to show the demographic background, success rates, and term to term persistence of students that participate in student services at Norco College.

Fall 2010 and Spring 2011 were the terms used to obtain demographic background data (race, gender, and ethnicity)1. The term to term persistence tables and charts examine the persistence of students from Fall 2010 to Spring 2011.

Calworks student records were only available for Spring 2011. Hence, term to term persistence tables and charts were not created for the Calworks section. Spring 2011 was the term used to obtain demographic background data and examine success rates.

Student records were provided for each of the student services and the data was self-reported. This may explain the difference between the term to term persistence rates when comparing this updated report to the prior version developed in October, 2008.

Referential files were used to obtain the data included in this report. Students that received a grade of a "UG" (ungraded) were excluded from the data used for this study.

Success is a grade of A, B, C, or P. Non success is any grade that is not successful. The success rates were obtained by dividing the number of successful grades by the total number of grades obtained by students (successful and non-successful). Only students that enrolled and received a grade were included in the data for this report.

Students that showed up in the data as "unknown/unrespondent" in terms of gender are excluded from the demographic charts. However, these students were still included in the term to term persistence charts. This explains the difference between the totals in the Fall 2010 demographic charts (student services and Norco College) when compared to the Fall 2010 totals in the term to term persistence charts.²
