

#### THE 23 OUTSTANDING CAMPUSES OF THE CSU

#### Minimum Admission Requirements:

- √ 60 CSU transferable units
- √ 30 units of general education
- ✓ 2.0 GPA resident/2.4 non-resident
- √ "Golden 4" courses:
  - English IA
  - ✓ Critical Thinking (COM-2, COM-3, ENG-1B, PHI-11, PHI/MAT-32 or REA-4)
  - ✓ Communication Studies (COM 1, 6 or 9)
  - ✓ Transferable Math
- ✓ Be in good standing at last institution



#### ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT)

Save time and money! Earn both associate and bachelor's degrees with 120 total semester units.

#### **ADTs Provide:**

- GUARANTEED ADMISSION to a CSU campus in the same major as your ADT
- Admitted at junior standing (no surprise lower division courses to take after transfer)
- Priority admission consideration which is helpful when applying to non-local CSUs
- Finish your baccalaureate degree with 60 more semester units



#### **DISCLAIMERS**

- Guarantee is not for all 23 CSU campuses. If you are not admitted into one of the CSU campuses that you apply to, your application will be redirected (free of charge) to a campus that is less impacted and has space in your major. Common redirection campuses include:

#### ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT) REQUIREMENTS



- Minimum of 60 CSU-transferable semester units, 12 of which must be completed at Norco College
- ✓ Completion of the CSUGE or IGETC general education breadth patterns
- ✓ Completion of required ADT major coursework with grades of "C" or better.
- ✓ Minimum 2.0 GPA (2.4 for non-residents) in all CSU-transferable coursework. While a minimum of 2.0 is required for admission, some majors may require a higher GPA. Please consult with a counselor for more information.

#### Minimum Admission Requirements:

- ✓ 60 **UC**-transferable semester units
- ✓ 2.4 GPA / 2.8 for non-resident
- Be in good academic standing
- ✓ Complete 7 course pattern:
  - ✓ 2 English (ENG IA & IB)
  - ✓ I mathematical concepts and quantitative reasoning
  - ✓ 4 courses from at least 2 of the following:
    - ✓ Arts and Humanities
    - ✓ Physical and Biological Sciences
    - ✓ Social and Behavioral Sciences



#### UC TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE (AKA TAG)


- Transfer Admission Guarantee
- Students can only TAG <u>one</u> participating UC campus  $\rightarrow$   $\rightarrow$
- Some majors are excluded (ask your counselor!)
- Qualifications vary depending on the UC (ask your counselor!)
- Submit FREE TAG application between September 1 30 (or May 1 30 for winter/spring admission)
- Create UC <u>T</u>ransfer <u>A</u>dmission <u>P</u>lanner (TAP) account to apply for TAG
  - Students self-report academic information
  - Personal Insight Questions (PIQs) not due at time of TAG submission but with UC application
- You still have to submit regular UC application between
   November I 30 (or July I 30 for winter/spring admission)



#### BENEFITS OF TAG

- Save time on your UC application your TAP account can be imported
- Some campuses notify you early of your TAG acceptance
- Students admitted via TAG are <u>admitted</u> often with a lower GPA than if they didn't apply for TAG
  - For example, UC Irvine's admitted transfer students for the computer science and engineering program in Fall 2018 had a 3.75 3.99 admit GPA. Whereas the TAG GPA for UC Irvine is 3.40.





- Flexibility 6 starts per year

- I 0% discount for PT students




#### **WGU**



- Flexibility pay per term, not unit
- Complete BA/BS degree in 6 -24 months after ADT
- Competency Based Model (Pre-test)
- 6 month term =\$3225
- Application Fee waiver
- Scholarship opportunities

#### HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES & UNIVERSITIES (HBCU)



- First HBCU was established in 1837 Cheney University
- HBCUs were established primarily to serve the higher education needs of the African-American community, however, they are open to students of all ethnicities.
- There are 107 HBCUs spread across 19 states, with most located in the south and on the eastern coast of the United States.
- 51 of HBCUs are *public* institutions and 56 are *private* institutions.

#### GUARANTEED ADMISSION TO PARTICIPATING HBCUS

Thanks to an agreement signed March 17, 2015, between the California Community Colleges and several HBCUs, California community college students who complete a minimum 30 transferrable semester units with a 2.5 GPA or have an ADT degree have GUARANTEED ADMISSION to one of the 39 participating HBCUs. There may be additional prerequisites or other requirements for certain majors.

#### **Additional Benefits for CCC Students**

- Application fee waiver to apply to four (4) participating HBCUs
- Priority housing consideration
- Scholarship opportunities
- Junior standing with Associate Degree
- Great option for CA impacted majors like nursing or STEM
- Focused counseling, and more!


#### **OUT-OF-STATE OPTIONS**



- 11% of all California residents who enroll in college do so out of state.
- Most attend schools in Arizona (14.3%) and Oregon (8.5%).
- The following thirteen states combined represent 70% of all out-of-state enrollment:
  - Arizona
  - Oregon
  - New York
  - Washington
  - Texas
  - Massachusetts
  - Colorado
  - Nevada
  - Utah
  - Illinois
  - Idaho
  - Pennsylvania
  - Indiana


