Fellows will gain valuable experience in the solar and non-profit industry to help launch their career while making significant contributions to GRID Alternatives and the broader community. The program is in partnership with AmeriCorps National Direct and will begin work **August 26th, 2019** in various locations.

POSITIONS:

Construction: support various aspects of PV installations for low-income families.

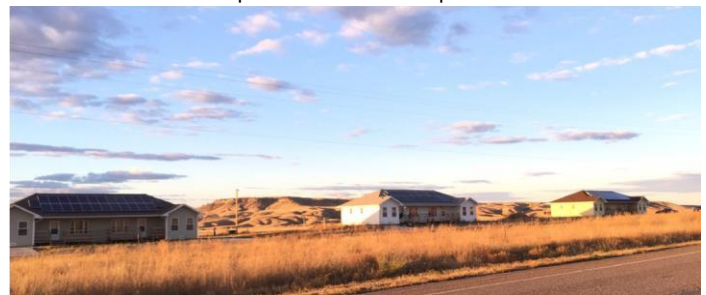
Outreach: work with the outreach team to partner with local agencies, community organizations, and others and identify and work directly with low-income clients.

Workforce Development and Volunteer: support volunteers and job trainees to learn solar and secure employment in the solar industry.

BENEFITS: The SolarCorps Fellowship experience includes self-paced career development opportunities, training and support provided by the SolarCorps support team, as well as the opportunity for cross-regional collaboration with other SolarCorps Fellows at several GRID Alternatives training events. Fellows will also be enrolled in the SolarCorps Alumni Network for ongoing workforce development opportunities.

SolarCorps Fellows will be provided:

- A living stipend of \$25,060 for first 10.5 months of serving at GRID Alternatives in partnership with AmeriCorps.
- Hourly wage of \$15/hr and Paid Time Off for last 2.5 months serving at GRID Alternatives.
- Health and Dental Insurance.
- Continuing education opportunities.
- Segal AmeriCorps Education award of \$5,775 upon successful completion of fellowship.
