Norco College staff has brought to the attention of the ACCJC that the College will be offering eight certificates and Associate of Science (AS) degrees. The information provided by the College indicates these degrees do not contain new courses or substantial changes, but instead reformat existing curriculum. The new certificates and degrees are:

- Computer Numerical Control Programming (29 unit certificate; 60 unit AS degree)
- Digital Electronics (29 unit certificate and 60 unit degree)
- Game Art: 3D Animation (40 unit certificate and 60 unit AS degree)
- Game Art: Character Modeling (37 unit certificate; 60 unit AS degree)
- Game Art: Environments and Vehicles (31 unit certificate and 60 unit AS degree)
- Game Audio (37 unit certificate and 60 unit AS degree)
- Game Design (30 unit certificate and 60 unit AS degree)
- Supply Chain Technology (25-29 unit certificate; 60 unit AS degree)

Based on the information provided by College staff, the aforementioned changes do not require a substantive change review by the Commission.
