Training

Canvas is the LMS platform that is used by the District, and while thirdparty LMS platforms are available and widely used, they must be integrated with Canvas when possible. This will solve issues of accreditors being able to view discussion forums and to verify that online assignments make up a student's grade.

Instructors who plan to teach in any mode which requires the use of Canvas (online, hybrid or webenhanced) must first complete Canvas training at RCCD. This can be done fully online through Online Canvas Academy, OR face-to-face at your college with one of the District Educational Technology Trainers. In addition to basic instruction on Canvas, the Canvas training covers administrative policies and procedures for online instruction, 508 compliance & accessibility, accreditation information, as well as additional district services and resources available for distance education instructors.
