PLEASE READ ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION PRIOR TO MAKING YOUR APPOINTMENT

In order to successfully schedule a counseling appointment, you must meet the following criteria:

- First-time Norco college students must complete Orientation, Assessment and Counseling (OAC) at least 1 to 2 business days prior to scheduling a counseling appointment.
- Transfer students who want to see a counselor to develop a Student Educational Plan (SEP) must ensure that the college has received all previous transcripts (see WebAdvisor) prior to scheduling a counseling appointment.
- Only students who have selected Norco College as their home college may make a counseling appointment at Norco College.

Please Note: Appointments are available during the spring and fall sessions only. During the winter and summer sessions we offer Drop-in Counseling on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Veterans and VA Dependents: If you need a Student Educational Plan (SEP) for veteran's benefits, you must make an appointment with the Veterans Resource Center (by email veterans.services@norcocollege.edu, phone (951) 372-7142, or in person). Transcripts on file will be evaluated and your program of study will be officially approved before your SEP is developed.

To make an Appointment log-on here:

2. Enter your birthdate
