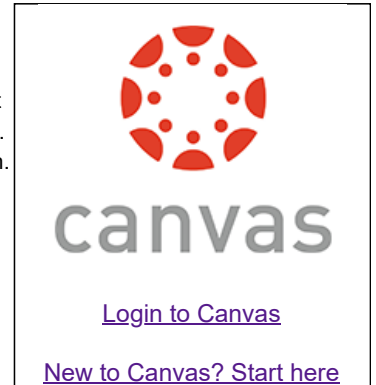




## Getting Started with Online Learning

If you're interested in the idea of online learning, but you still aren't sure if it is really for you, think about what it offers. Online learning is convenient and provides flexibility to complete your coursework any time day or night. But, you may be wondering if online learning is different from taking the same course in a traditional classroom. Online courses are not for everyone. They require at least as much time and commitment as traditional courses. Before you consider taking an online course, make sure you have time to focus on your coursework, feel competent using computers, and have good reading and writing communication skills. ### Is online learning for me?

The online environment is not for everyone. Unfortunately, some people may have an unrealistic impression or the incorrect idea that taking online classes is the "easy" route. Although you might not have to attend classes, you will still have to:

- read your textbooks and other materials
- write papers
- engage in class discussions with classmates/teachers by posting to discussion boards
- complete activities, tests or other assessments
- participate in individual and group projects
- spend as much time on your online class as you would if attending on campus

### How do I login my Distance Education classes?

**NOTE: If you recently registered, it may take up to 4 hours before you will be able to access.**

- Before logging into Canvas, be sure that your browser & system have met the requirements listed on [the Canvas system requirements page](#).
- Go to the **Canvas login**. All distance education courses are accessed from the [Distance Education webpage](#).
- Your username is the same as your RCCD issued student email address.  
Examples for an RCCD student email address with the name of John Doe might be:
