Interdisciplinary artist Jonathan Godinez explores the hidden frameworks of identity and memory in his art exhibit titled *Internal Construction*. Through a mix of sculpture, painting, and multimedia installations, the exhibition examines the ways we build, deconstruct, and reconstruct our inner worlds. Through the use of architectural metaphors and references to consumerism, the artist reveals the unseen structures that shape his thoughts, relationships, and personal narratives. *Internal Construction* invites viewers to reflect on the foundations of their own psyche and the ever-evolving nature of self-construction.

Jonathan Godinez is an interdisciplinary Mexican-American artist born and raised in Tijuana, Mexico. At the age of eight, he and his family moved to Riverside, California, in search of a better future. He attended Norco College and Riverside City College for his foundational studies before transferring to California State University, Long Beach, where he earned his Bachelor's degree in Studio Arts in 2021. Jonathan continued his art education and earned a Master of Fine Arts degree from Claremont Graduate University in 2024.


