    - Polled students on the ease of use, navigation, understanding, intuitive (students overwhelming liked the site)
    - Assists students with first 15 units, degrees, including degree patterns and certificates
    - Basic Skills has its own off shoot
    - Suggestions:
      - a. Gail felt that the website should include Certificates in the “other” areas
      - b. Add a banner to the Website
      - c. Create sense of belonging

##### A. Academic Affairs Prioritization

- iii. Dr. Dieckmeyer would like to create a subgroup (that she will chair) to ensure that the needs of Academic Affairs are met.
  - The subgroup would meet three times in Fall.
    - a. create the criteria
    - b. establish priority
    - c. Get it done
- iv. Dr. Dieckmeyer requested concept approval – approved
  - Gail requested that at least one member of the subgroup be from CTE, agreed. Patty Worsham will be their representative.
  - The committee also suggested that someone from another function participate, possibly from the Technology Committee.

- ii. Alexis Gray nominated Melissa Bader to assume the position for the duration of the Spring Semester, she accepted. Approved

##### C. FTEs discussion

- i. Dr. Parks reviewed the current status of FTEs for 2016/2017
  - The District as a whole is down 630 FTEs
  - Expect to add 50 FTEs to 17 Summer, possibly more because we cancelled a lot of sections in Spring
  - Focus on retaining students

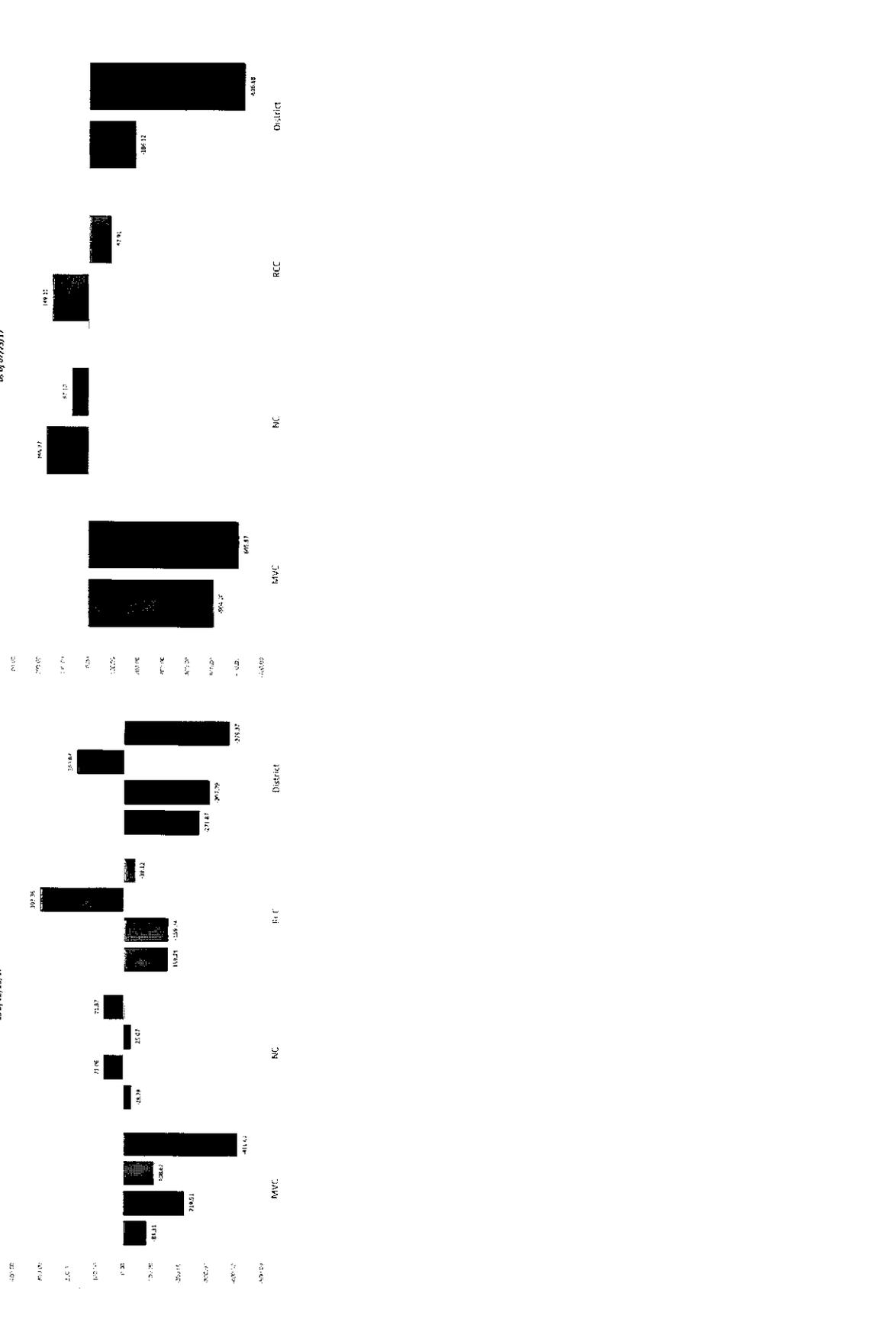
