VIII. College Reports

A. Associated Students of Norco College (A. Calderon, S. Irfan)

- There will be an event on April 23rd with magician Kevin Blake at 5 pm.
- ASNC Presidents got together with the Student Trustee and came up with a survey for students that will be emailed out regarding returning to campus in the fall- It will be forwarded to faculty to share with students.
- District sent out surveys and received about 3,000 responses but have not been shared with ASNC.
- First 100 students to respond to email will receive \$25 gift card.

B. College President/Vice-President Academic Affairs (M. Green/S. Lee) President Green:

- Chancellor and presidents meet regularly and ensure that we are reporting to each of our colleges.
- The Strategic Planning and Governance manual is going to the Board of Trustees for presentation tomorrow (Thank you Dr. Fleming for his leadership and the Academic Senate).
- Thank you to the entire college for their contribution to the Strategic Plan and Governance manual.
- We are working to consolidate multiple programs under a single administrator as well as long-term leadership. (Programs to include- Dual Enrollment, Summer Bridge Program, Prison Education, Competency Based Education and Credit for Prior Learning)
- This will result in an Associate Dean of Educational Partnerships.
- This will not increase the number of managers at the college and will align with RCC structure.

Vice President Lee:

- Schedule will be published on May 17th and registration begins June 1st.
