Raiann Discussion: Discussed what to do with grant money. Grant money goes towards grant and percentage of that money is to go towards what the institution deems needed. - 1. Sent out emails for CCCSAA. CCCSAA is a conference that invites people from all over the states that are involved in student government at California community college. It is a networking event. It focuses on marketing and activities. There is a representative on the board of governor. CCC is the voice of the student at the statewide level. So you have and opportunity to meet your region. All the meals and rooms are covered.

#### X. Executive/Committee Reports

<u>Administration</u>: Constitution Day is on September 18th. We will be giving away constitution booklets and prizes for those who complete a 10-question quiz and turn it in to Edwin. There will be a first, second and third place winner.

Question: What will be the prizes being passed out? ASNC has lots of T shirts to give away, there are USB, water bottle, key chain. When creating the fliers, please do not put what the prizes will be.

**<u>Finance</u>**: - Waiting on invoice from Odili (to pay for food, update with that)

- Soccer has been updated, there is a \$2,000 difference between what I have and the expenditures in district
- a. Line items are over, but overall expenditures are accurate
- b. Soccer did take out of other line items, but dispersing correctly will probably make things worse
- c. Soccer bought folders \$40, need to figure out where to pull that from
- Lean-in Circle was actually a Reimbursement for Anita (123) accounted for
- Nothing but the \$100 cash advance has been inputted for Activities
- a. Waiting on Odealy for food expenditures
- Updated cash advance from retreat (Edwin didn't use the whole \$3,500)
- Veterans bought food for Meeting; it is not okay (Descp. Says events only)

<u>Activities</u>: Pink week is from October 9th to the 11th during college hour and on the 11th, that will be the same day as the Pep Rally as well. Pep Rally was moved because soccer team cannot attend the rally. Pep Rally is in the amp theater. All three days will be from 12:50pm – 1:50pm. Next week, she will not be available at all, so go to her senators for any information.

**<u>Relations</u>**: So far, the social media page is getting bigger. They had 480 followers and now they have 505 followers.

<u>Organization</u>: Tomorrow is the last day of club rush so if you want volunteer hours, you can help tear down.

**President**: Met with Dr. Reese and will now sit on the higher committee as the student rep. Last semester we had, students sign up for the accreditation meeting. Recommend student sits in the meeting that is their shared governance. There are four standards. Standard 1 is Mission, Academic, Quality and Intuitional Effectiveness and Integrity. There are 10 different topics that the accreditation as a whole focus on. Accreditation is next spring. **BFPC committee**: They prioritizes requests for budget allocations and augmentation.

**Library committee**: They discussed going on the website to see when the librarian is available. You can make an appointment with a tutor. Also, they were also talking about opening the library until 5 pm on Friday and opening the Library on Saturdays.

<u>Curriculum committee</u>: MAT 35 is going to be the starting class for student. MAT 10 is going to be 5 units instead of 4.

<u>Safety committee</u>: There were the discussing the possibility of doing an active student shooting drill. They talked about the light by the STEM building. People either stop to long

or close to hitting students. Also, they're considering creating a gate to close the campus on weekend. Download the RAVE guardian app.

<u>Question</u>: For the next safety committee, can you remind me so I (Autumn) can attend it with you because I have had students complain to me saying that they do want active shooter drills for the students? Yeah. (Shawn)

*Marketing committee*: The veterans club created a new logo for themselves. \*passed around the new logo poster\*

Academic Senate committee: Went to the Academic senate meeting and student will now be introduced to an EW which is an Excused Withdraw and this is going to be incarcerated student. If released after drop date, they will have an EW. Also, for DACA student as well. Students can go to Admission and Records and talk to them about their circumstances. Veterans have something similar called the MW which is called the Military Withdraw which is when they are getting deployed. EW does not count as an attempt, but it shows on the transcript

Question: So, with the way Norco College works is that if you fail a class more than three tikes you can no long take it within the RCC district (Norco College, Moreno Valley, Riverside Community College). You would have to take it at a different school, for example Chaffey College. So, with the new EW system, if I get an EW more than three times can I still retake the class at Norco or would I have to leave and go to a different school?
