VIII. ASNC Advisor Report

- The Coronavirus has been becoming a more popular topic and they sent out an email to cancel all travel.
- In other colleges they are cancelling all events that have over 100 people. Also, other campuses are making their classes online.
- There will be a travel ban starting March 30th.
- Faculty has recommended that we go into online classes, but the administration has not said yet. Professors should start preparing for online classes in case it goes to that extreme.
