The Associated Students of Norco College will support Academic Council's Student Spotlight by providing \$50 gift cards for up to 14 students selected via the Academic Council's processes.

Twice a year we recognize one student from the college and identify these students by equity. This is based on the equity audit from 2023. The award recognizes students who demonstrate equity-minded behaviour, goodwill, and positive community impact rather than focusing solely on academic performance. Students are selected each fall and spring through a vote of the Academic Senate. Previously, each student has received a \$50 Amazon gift card; however, due to a funding shortfall in December, the program was unable to provide the award to two recipients, and additional support will be needed to sustain the program moving forward.

Discussion:

Ethan: I was wondering about the potential increase in competition this may arise in students in obtaining this reward?

Basically, the students don't even know that this is happening, so there is no competition as they are not aware that there is any incentive for their behaviour.
