**Senate 03.13.01 Proposal to Amend Inter Club Council Finance Policies, Sections 2, 7, and 9.**

**Motion Author: Ashley Yoon  
(Action Item)**

*The Associated Students of Norco College will review and vote upon proposed amendments to the Inter Club Council Finance Policies. The proposed changes modify Section 2 to clarify that clubs forfeit the right to reimbursement if receipts are not submitted within the 48-hour window; Section 7 to add attendance at all mandatory ICC events as a requirement for funding eligibility; Section 9 to require that cost documentation be submitted prior to a request being placed on the agenda.*

*Discussion:*

*Ashley: We're just reiterating that receipts must be submitted within 48 hours because that was the original intention with this policy. We're probably going to remove Club Rush attendance as mandatory since that falls under ICC events.*

*Tristan: Do the slides count as documentation?*

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*Ashley: Oh yeah, just like some clubs say that they are spending a certain amount of money, but they won't show the receipts*

*Tristan: What happens if someone buys something from Amazon as the item was on sale, and when they go back to it, it's not? What happens if they have an unexpected expense?*

*Ashley: That's fine, some clubs go over the \$200 reimbursement. As long as you purchase whatever you presented at ICC, it is fine.*

General Discussion:

The focus should be shifted from getting a bunch of information out to having productive discussion. Maybe coming with 1 or 2 questions from each week's committee meetings would work better.
