**Senate 04.03.01 Approval of \$5302.50 from Rugby Account (92634) to fund additional fees associated with the ASNC Mustang Statue.**

**(Action Item)**

*The Associated Students of Norco College will review and vote on approval of funding to cover the remaining costs associated with designing and installing the statue.*

*Discussion:*

*Dr. Romero: Not my choice to use our money this way. The class of 2017 had approved up to 50k to go towards the construction of the statue, which included the architectural plans. But the campus was unable to cover up the cost of the ramp that was supposed to be built along the statue. They are now asking ASNC to cover the concrete fees as they covered up the construction fees on your behalf.*

*Dr.romero: Rugby is not inactive, so their budget is not being used.*

*Ashley: Where does the budget of rugby go if we were to say no?*

*Dr.romero: It would stay in executive contingency for now.*

*Silvio: Can we use rugby money for ASNC banquet?*

**Senate 04.03.02 Approval of ASNC Response to (N)ISER, standard 2.8.**

**(Action Item)**

*The Associated Students of Norco College will review and vote on approval of an official response to this new campus standard.*

*Hussam: So, the (N)ISER is essentially NC college accreditation review. They specifically asked ASNC for our feedback.*

*Tristan: Is this like a district thing?*

*Hussam: This is Norco College's formal review for accreditation. Let's say you have a serious concern regarding the transfer centre.*

*Hussam: 2.4: The institution communicates clear, accurate, and accessible information regarding programs, services, and resources that foster success in students' unique educational journeys. No feedback? Okay. 2.5: The institution holds itself accountable for students' success by scheduling courses in a manner that ensures degree and certificate programs can be completed in the expected period of time.*

*Tristan: Do stem people have a problem with scheduling classes while being in ASNC?*

*Hussam: Yeah, mainly with college hour. Moving on, 2.6: The institution uses delivery modes and teaching methodologies that meet student and curricular needs and promote equitable student learning and achievement. 2.7: The institution designs and delivers equitable and effective services and programs that support students in their unique educational journeys, address academic and non-academic needs, and maximize their potential for success. Such services include library and learning resources, academic counselling and support, and other services the institution identifies as appropriate for its mission and student needs.*
