Senate 10.31.03 Harvest Festival Reflection

The Associated Students of Norco College will reflect on how Harvest Festival was ran and discuss on what went well and what could be improved.

Motion: Ashley
Second: Marcos

Ethan: The decorations went well and notes for Tristan is to take into consideration how long it takes for inflatables to be set up in the trees. One key takeaway is the need for better delegation, such as with tasks like distributing candy. Many people were unsure who to approach other than Ashley. Additionally, hosting candy at the ASNC booth would be a great idea for next year

Discussion:

Salma: Harvest fest went well, but I feel like there was no structure. For next time, there needs to be more communication and more humanity. I talked to several clubs, Pheonix

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Scholar Club and Business Law Club had 10 people were working at the club. They said they want a better tone from Ashley when asking her questions. They felt like her tone was gravitating towards a “deal with it” attitude when brought with a problem.

Jared: For the candy, clubs can utilize the Wishlist to have some funds in there for candy since it also runs out. Communication with the clubs and ASNC was good, but the event could have been more organized, and no expired candy should have been there.

Salma: Pumpkin painting and the dunk tanks were very successful at Harvest Fest.

Jared: There should be one shift for everyone for setup, since there was not a lot of work at electrical team, and help could be used elsewhere.

Ethan: There were some people at ASNC who didn't pull their weight in set up and would be in the office too long. The reason we separated the setup teams was so that everything gets done. For the future it might be changed for everyone to oversee everything if people aren't doing work. ASNC needs to be better at pulling their weight in their shifts, and communication needs to be worked on.

Ashley: If electrical team or light team is done early, they should help other people and not just sit in the office.

Cole: We should work on flexibility as a whole team and to help other teams when in need. If lots of people are on their break, please be willing to help.

Ashley: Needed help from different booths and took a lot of convincing to even get help. The response that I would get is that they already did their (electrical) shift.

Salma: There should have been communication with facilities for the club booths.

Abby: Electrical team wanted to help, but there were some confusions with communication on what to do. Electrical team did their job and helped with canopies.

Ashley: Ashley mentioned that the electrical team did provide help, but some members had to be persuaded to contribute rather than volunteering willingly.

Dr. Romero: One possible solution is to plan a meeting before setting up to start with, so people know what to do. It will take 10-15 minutes to get everyone on the same page, and it would be worth it.

AJ: We should have a Walkie Talkie system to communicate in the events.

Tristan: I provided a brief overview of the tasks, which helped us get started quickly with the decorations. However, a more detailed debrief would be beneficial at the start of set up in the future since a lot of people might have forgotten what they were told in senate a week before.

Salma: Was very hectic to find the pins for the inflatables, and other items needed for decorations like string. Having a day before where all the items are arranged for easy findings would be beneficial.

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Ashley: We should have a ladder.

Abby: During cleanup, a lot of people weren't doing their part, and it is bad for the morale if people are not doing a lot of work.

Dr. Romero: The Harvest Fest received overwhelmingly positive raving feedback. The golf carts stood out as a highlight for me, and the Just Dance activity drew a large, enthusiastic crowd.

Ashley: I wanted to highlight everything that went well and appreciate the work you guys put in especially in the heat. The layout was very well; our ASNC booth went very well and no one got hurt. There was only one lost kid that got found. Relations put out really good videos!

AJ: We should use the walkie talkie the NOMU event so we can even call out to people.

Jared: I have used the walkie talkie at work, and I would recommend the one with the earpieces.
