Approval of up to \$700 from Executive Contingency (92199) to Purchase Promotional Gift Cards for Student Spotlight Motion Author: Eric Doucette (Action Item)

The Associated Students of Norco College will support Academic Council's Student Spotlight by providing \$50 gift cards for up to 14 students selected via the Academic Council's processes.

Motion: Sil Second: Ashley

Funding for Student Spotlight. Every month a student gets a spotlight from the school; you can get a nomination from your professors. \$50 gift cards for 14 students. ASNC should get recognition for the sponsorship.

Discussion:

Ethan: Why are we giving the students \$50 instead of \$25 gift cards to students?

Sil: I think we should keep the amount at \$50 because it makes more sense as an award and students will be more motivated to work harder.

Bobby: So why are we giving Eric money when he isn't even here for his presentation?

Hannah: How much money have we given for the promotional gift cards in the past?

This would be the first time we would do this

Abby: I still believe it should be \$50 per student, as the contingency fund is meant for initiatives that directly benefit students. This is a great incentive since many of these students juggle jobs while focusing on school. Offering this award would be a meaningful way to recognize their hard work

Tristan: We can't just do a VISA gift card? The only problem is that those have a fee when used.

Bobby: I understand both perspectives, and I agree that incentivizing students is important. However, requesting funds without providing detailed information makes it hard to justify pulling money from our budget

Ashley: With Eric attending the next meeting, we'll have the chance to ask the right questions and gather more details. That will help us make a more informed decision.
