ERA's are doing the UC's and CSU's workshop. I handle the PIQS. Applications should be done before Thanksgiving, so you aren't stressed. The Cal state applications are more complex, and it is recommended to get assistance. Drop-in times are available from Tuesday and Thursday 12-2pm, and Wednesdays 3-5pm. 10-7pm for 11/24, 11/25, & 11/26. The Hard deadline is December 1 for UC Applications. On December 1, counselling will be open from 12-8 pm for assistance. Norco College is offering one free coupon for CSUs/ UC for assistance to pay for applications. First comes first serve, only Norco college students who have registered for 2 semesters will be considered. First time college students only; for students without any high school concurrent/dual enrollment. This can guarantee admission for Cal States.
