Senate 09.04.02 Read to Succeed Initiative Proposal

The Associated Students of Norco College will review and vote on approval of oversight and funding for the Read to Succeed initiative.

Discussion:

Damon: Came to ASNC last spring, proposing an idea of more funding to the “Read to Succeed” program. Described the monthly structure of the original program and partnership with equity groups. Mentioned partnering with other clubs on campus, bringing authors forms books being read in the program. Mentioned how ASNC felt it could not take on responsibility to manage the program, and the biggest problem being the flow of ASNC not aligning with other programs and hoping for it to improve over the next academic year.

Revised Proposal: Do a once a year event in the Spring, approve the budget in the fall, asking for ASNC to buy around 100 books for students.

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Ameera: Advised a written proposal for better outcome.

Damon: Asked for ASNC to help, with priority in the help of funding. Originally was paying \$5000 author honorarium, reduced to \$3500, open to going lower to \$2500. Proposed a returning author, alongside a secondary option. Continuously mentioned the need of ASNC's help in buying books, estimated at \$1500. Working towards discounts on the books, with no guarantee. In total, requesting about \$4000. Looking to partner with MOC, or Phoenix, or Unity Zone for this Spring.

Ameera: Again, mentioned a written proposal, and confirmed "Read to Succeed" needing primarily funding and promoting. To be rediscussed 2 senate meetings from today (9/18/26).

Adishvar: Mentioned needing concrete numbers for budgeting, expressed that the Executive Committee needed to discuss their Executive Contingency budget allocation for the rest of the year ahead of any approval.

Damon: No longer able to use library lottery funding. Advocated to keep the program going after 14 years of hard work within itself.

Jonathan: Asked how much of ASNC's executive budget would be used if funding the program.

Arinze: Requesting a final asking price for all needed to be provided in the upcoming week(s).

Adishvar: Agreed in keeping the club alive for the better of the students and campus, suggested Damon to propose \$3500 rather than \$2500 for no further budget issues in the program down the line. Requested time to speak further with the executive board.

Ameera: Moved to discuss the motion further on 9/18/26, after further discussion with the executive board.

VII. ASNC Advisor Report

Dr. Romero:

- Making it clear that ASNC's first big event will not be easy.
- We will have a booth serving pizza, students can get in line to receive a slice. We will be helping with setup & bringing out table covers which are first-come first-serve, so if there is an empty table, any club may take it. We have about 5-6 brand new clubs that may come out. They can take 1 table, 3 chairs, and a canopy. We will have extra

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tables that can be requested and found in the ASNC office. Some external organizations are coming, like RTA, and they are bringing their own canopy, we are providing the table and chairs. ASNC will have a booth right in the middle, there will be 3 generators, if you know how to start it, feel free to, otherwise see Dr. Romero. Clubs may not drag extension cords across the walkway.

- Those approved to drive may drive the golf cart as well.
- Clubs may not have club sign-up sheets on their tables, as the information is then available to anyone. Clubs may not record Student IDs or other personal information. There is a sign-up sheet created by the student life office that will be posted as a QR code at all the booths. This will record student IDs, and allow Student Life Office to verify student eligibility.
- The club charter deadline is October 1st, clubs may ask about that if needed.
- The storage room will be open for club officers to take whatever they need, given they bring it back.
- We will provide them storage space on Wednesday for Thursday's event within the office. They must take the items back eventually.
- Music is allowed as long as it is not foul. There will be a speaker at our booth.
- Anyone staffing the booth is allowed to get food without doing the scavenger hunt. Each club will get 3-4 tickets they can use to redeem for pizza. Those without tickets will need to complete the scavenger hunt. Those without tickets will also wait in line to be served. Anyone with a ticket may request pizza without waiting.
