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Senate 09.11.02 Approval of \$12,980 from Executive Contingencies (92199) to Pay for Architectural Fees Related to the Mustang Statue Project

The Associated Students of Norco College will review and vote on approving the payment of architectural fees.

Discussion:

Dr. Romero: Discussed the value and why the statue was made, Cost: \$50,000. The campus was not in line with ADA causing them to delay. Due to not having an ADA compliant ramp near the entrance, needed to fix the ramp in order to get back in line, upwards of \$100k. The project was postponed pending the installation of the ramp. The statue was originally conceptualized to help ASNC spend its budget. The architect had to resubmit plans. ASNC approved an additional \$8,500 for the ramp, the architect claims they are still owed \$12,980 for architecture. Is unsure what these fees are for, clarification pending.

Meeting Called Back to Order (10:26 AM)

Discussion:

Travonne Bell: Acknowledges the statue was donated under different ASNC leadership. Once the statue was received, the project was halted until the 2025-2026 academic school year. Remaining balance of \$13,000 but also presented additional fees from the architect prior to construction. The request was made for \$12,980 and the originally approved \$8500, assuming request was made, invoices were requested and paid in full. Can we move forward with this yes. Discrepancy happened above \$8500, new PO and old PO. Fees due on the Old PO that is where the \$12,980. Construction administration fee's, architect hired to view and look over that is approved by the state. Through division of state architect and required to come back to look and make sure that the project has been completed. The design for the ramp was included in the cost for the 28k.

Ameera: What happens if ASNC does not fund, what happens...?

Travonne Bell: Have to talk with administration of the college.

Chika: Suggested spreading payment throughout the future years, building maybe a multi-year payment plan.

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Travonne Bell: Can request from administration, and will get back to the ASNC.

Adishvar: The exec team has \$31k left for the year, which is meant to benefit the students for events and fun as well as other activities. Does not make sense for the \$13k to be asked of this budget, assuming ASNC has already contributed a significant amount. Does not agree with it coming out with the executive budget, does not align with why.

Ameera: The District never asked about the mustang statue. Wondering why the executive board did not ask ASNC for the statue.

Travonne Bell: The college would have not approved of the statue, had ASNC not have approved such a budget in the prior years.

Adishvar: Look back over the past minutes to confirm and clarify how much funding was allocated to the statue. Presuming it was an administrative shortfall.

Chika: Are you able to tell us how much the cost of the ramp and the statue is individually?

Travonne Bell: From the total cost of \$160k, \$85k was approved by ASNC when it was bought. The college specifically let the student body at the time know that they have to pay for the statue and ASNC approved of that.

Adishvar: What year was it approved?

Travonne Bell: 2025-2026, confirmed with Dr. Romero.

Dr. Romero: Paid the \$8500 in May, where did it end up?

Adishvar: Dr. Romero said \$8500, wasn't that approved last year

Dr. Romero: Appreciated chika recommendation to break it up over the future years.

Rosio Beccera: are we unsure if we are lost where the 8500 went

Travonne Bell: We have P.O. 33779, another one open 4242, some of the invoices that have been listed and have not, until Dr. Romero sees discrepancy between what this is and what this is for. Revised the old post, raising a red flag. The \$8500 could have already been paid out, but we are still requesting \$13k, having the unsureness on the fulfillment of the \$8500.

Travonne: Highly recommended to have architects on campus.

Ameera: Can we organize this for the future to be able to talk with the architect.

Dr. Romero: The information that is important is the cost of the actual statue, figure out how much the district has actually paid and how much ASNC has already paid, which is \$54k.
