



START HERE: Curriculum Mapping




METHOD 1: Aggregate Existing SLO Results



Use Method 1 if your program:

- ☐ Has already completed curriculum mapping
- ☐ Has up-to-date assessment results for most courses & SLOs
- □ Needs to look at PLO attainment across courses within your program
- ☐ Wants to identify trends over time

METHOD 2: Assess in a Capstone Assignment



Use Method 2 if your program:

- ☐ Has already completed curriculum mapping
- ☐ Has a capstone assignment that directly links to one or more PLOs
- □ Needs to assess student mastery at the culmination of your program
- ☐ Your PLO is competency or skill based
