How to Score Assessment Outcome Rubric

Purpose

Once your rubric is created and linked to outcomes, follow these steps to use it for grading and to record assessment results automatically in Canvas.

Step 1: Open the Grading Tool

- Go to the assignment in your Canvas course.
- Click SpeedGrader from the right sidebar.

Step 2: Open and Apply the Rubric

- In SpeedGrader, click **View Rubric** (or the rubric icon).
- Click the appropriate performance level (0-4) for each criterion.
- Add comments as needed, then click Submit Assessment.

Step 3: Move Efficiently Between Students

- Use the arrows in SpeedGrader to move to the next student.
- Repeat rubric clicks and save for each.

Step 4: Control Student View (Optional)

If you need to keep outcome scores hidden:

- Create a 0-point, unpublished "Assessment Only" copy of the assignment.
- Link outcomes and the rubric to that version.
- Grade the main assignment as usual, then click rubric scores on the mirrored version.

Step 5: Verify Results in the Learning Mastery Gradebook

- Go to Grades → Gradebook menu → Learning Mastery Gradebook.*
- Review real-time outcome results by student and outcome.

Enabling the Learning Mastery Gradebook in Canvas

Purpose:

The Learning Mastery Gradebook is where Canvas stores and displays SLO assessment results. If you don't see it listed under "Grades," it just needs to be enabled in your course settings.

Step 1: Open Course Settings

- Scroll to the bottom of your Course Navigation Menu (left-hand side).
- Click Settings.

Step 2: Select the "Feature Options" Tab

- At the top of the Settings page, select the **Feature Options** tab.
- Locate Learning Mastery Gradebook (sometimes labeled Mastery Gradebook).

Step 3: Enable the Feature

- Click the toggle switch next to Learning Mastery Gradebook so it turns green/on.
- You've now activated the feature for your course.

Step 4: Access the Gradebook

- 1. Go back to your **Grades** page.
- 2. Click the **Gradebook menu** (drop-down arrow next to "Gradebook").
- 3. Select Learning Mastery Gradebook.

Tip: If you still don't see it, try refreshing your browser or logging out/in.

What You'll See

- Outcome titles (e.g., ENG-1A_SLO-1).
- Performance bars showing average scores (0–4 scale).
- Student performance data by outcome updated as soon as you grade using your rubric.
