- **1. DE Proposal template:** Senate asked to have faculty refer to the best practices. District Curriculum not in favor of DE proposal template.
- **2. Units and Residency:** For a student to get a degree at Norco college, they must have at least 15 units minimum, Title V regulation is 12, but Norco chose to list 15. The issue is a student didn't have 15 units residency but completed all courses for an ADT. So for the students to earn their degree, they had to take another course, but it put them over the 60 units for ADT. The question is: It is a good idea for students taking ADT's, should we lower the residency units from 15 to 12. Committee agrees that we should lower it from 15 to 12 (across the board) to match inline to the standard consensus. Brian will take this recommendation to the senate.
