- 1. Curriculum Committee calendar 2016-2017: A handout was given to the committee members for the 2016-2017 meetings dates for Norco Curriculum committee, District Tech Review Committee and the District Curriculum committee. In the last transfer over to META, some items might be lost and so to be proactive, any new courses or modifications make sure you keep a record in a Word document of your work in case there was a data lost or not imported correctly. In CurricUNET, the originator can see where the course is at in the process. Any course modifications that your department started in the last semester and is still in CurricUNET; therefore, please send that list to Brian Johnson so he can track it. There was someone that was hired to replace Naomi Foley, and is still in the training process. The new hire's name was not provided to the committee. It was requested that our committee receive an 'introduction' email from the new hire replacement.
- **5. META Timeline and Related items:** Steven Schmidt is in talks with META and there will be a two week minimum before we can start using META. Hopefully, we will be able to use META in early October. There are links where you can add objectives as an option in META. We will be informed on when we should not use CurricUNET so they can perform the complete data transfer. Question: What about the historical CORs? Will they be housed in META? Can we save the historical data in CurricUNET? Maybe in a PDF and housed somewhere? Brian isn't not aware on what will happen to the historical information. More discussion on this is needed.
