#### E: Discussion:

a. META Update The issue right now is the login. The @rcc.edu isn't applying to everyone. Those with @norcocollege.edu need to use that login. So please try both to see which one works and if you still have any problems to please email Brian Johnson. The old CurricUNET is to have public access in META. The login is your @rcc.edu email address and the default password is: ChangeMe1. You can also click on "Forgot Password" and reset the password.

**DE Proposal:** Need to append "DE" on the end of the course number in META. You need to do this to finish the distance education proposal. It is becoming difficult in distinguishing what courses are Distance Education and which ones are not. The only work-around is to add the "DE" to the course number.

A, B, C, D lettering in the Codes/Dates section at the end of the COR in META mean nothing.

**ART-6-DE** proposal wasn't showing in META. The understanding if that you need to get to the old CurricUNET webpage and look under Distance Education completed proposals. It gives you a list of every single proposal that is put into CurricUNET and ART-6 is listed but not the distance education proposal. So it tells us that the DE proposal was not made before 2008. The list hasn't been updated since then and so we have no record to see anything after that. Courses that have DE approval prior to 2008 will not show in META. The distance education courses are currently the issue they have having with the launching of META. We do not have a complete and accurate record.

Question: Will there be a public view of META? Answer is that we will eventually have it.

b. Units Completed as a prerequisite: Judy Perry has asked about this and she has a game development program, and her students are required to take a large number of courses before they take the capstone course. The problem is that the capstone courses at some other college, the prerequisites is 20 units completed in the discipline. She is asking if this is something we can do for our COR's?? She would like it to be a discussion item now. Brian is not sure how the complete process works and would need to do more research. Web Advisor is able to recognize a set amount of completed units, but not the specific classes. Nick said he can ask the matriculation person to see if they can link it. More discussion and research is needed.
