N. Discussion items:

1. META Codes/ Data field: They are trying to create the catalog by taking the data from META but we need to make sure META is correct. Some of the fields our faculty are not filling out or entering the wrong information, and this needs to be corrected. Brian gave a detailed demonstration to the curriculum committee where to access the sections and what to enter. We need faculty to enter the TOPs code and transferability status. Brian will be asking the district curriculum committee what specific fields are faculty to complete, plus who is responsible to complete the other fields.

2. BIO course modifications and associated programs: The catalog isn't going to reflect the new BIO discipline changes. This is going to affect the other colleges since they will have the old course names. So for example BIO-11 will be renamed BIO-60 and Brian will bring it up to the district committee. This can cause issues for other students who are under the older program. Suggestions to add language "formerly known as". Also the cross listed courses. All the BIO programs need to be changed. Create a table of courses that changed.

3. Work Experience sentence of equivalency. First read Work Experience catalog language. Dr. Fleming gave the first reading and the second reading has been added to the agenda to the March 13, 2018 meeting. Occupational Work Experience Education

Work Experience is a one hour per week class which allows students to earn up to 4 units per semester for experience gained through employment or volunteer service. The content/curriculum for each discipline-specific course is identical to the general work experience course (WKX-200). Enroll in a general Work Experience section and you will be

placed in your choice of one of the disciplines below with the help of your instructor.

Next Meeting: March 13, 2018 Statement of Purpose

The curriculum committee, a sub-committee of the academic senate, has two primary purposes: to review and approve new curriculum including new courses, course modifications, new programs and program modifications, and to review and approve the curriculum approval process. The college curriculum committee is the sole approving body for Norco College only curriculum. For district shared curriculum it has one vote in the district curriculum committee. The curriculum committee is also responsible for keeping abreast with state mandated curriculum changes and reporting those changes to faculty. Committee members report on curriculum at their department meetings and solicit suggestions and recommendations when needed.
