MV CIS 824B Networking for Home and Small Businesses To support Adult Education and Community Initiatives, this course will provide adult learners with basic networking concepts that will help adult learners advance their personal and professional technical skills. This course will build interest in credit-based courses, such as CIS-26 and other IT or cybersecurity-related courses. Labor Market Employment Projection shows a steady growth in annual job openings, 148 in Riverside/San Bernardino County, 5730 in California; approximately 3-4% annual growth in computer networking related positions.
- ix. MV CIS 824C Cybersecurity for Beginners This non-credit course introduces learners to cybersecurity field in order to increase security awareness and drive interest for cybersecurity degree, Cybersecurity Healthcare certificate and field. According to Labor Market data for Inland Empire and Desert Region, there are 15% growth in employment opportunities for cybersecurity professionals in healthcare organizations, with average 125 new annual job postings between June 2017 and May 2018. This course will promote education in cybersecurity for personal or career growth.
- x. R CIS 825 Cyber Skills - Introduction to Cybersecurity This course was developed with 2 other Cyber Skills courses for a State-Approved Non-Credit Certificate of Completion that will assist with improving student employment.

MVC CIS 897A Windows Operating System and Internet Literacy This course provides basic methods to use Windows operating system for new users or users who are not familiar with Windows operating system. This course can serve as a preparatory course for CIS-1A or other CIS courses that utilizes Windows operating system. This course is designed to support Adult Education and Community Initiatives, which offers opportunities for adult learners to advance technical skills for personal and professional purposes.
- xix. MVC CIS 897B Linux Operating System and Internet Literacy This course supports Adult Education and Community Initiatives, in which new computer users can benefit from gaining technical skills for personal or professional purposes. This course can also serve as preparatory course to CIS-21 Operating System and CIS-21A Linux Operating System Administration. It provides opportunity for students to prepare for technical career by providing foundation in Linux operating system. This course can also draw interests to IT or Cybersecurity related certificates or degrees, which will help improve the region CTE outcome and economic growth.

Statement of Purpose

The curriculum committee, a sub-committee of the academic senate, has two primary purposes: to review and approve new curriculum including new courses, course modifications, new programs and program modifications, and to review and approve the curriculum approval process. The college curriculum committee is the sole approving body for Norco College only curriculum. For district shared curriculum it has one vote in the district curriculum committee. The curriculum committee is also responsible for keeping abreast with state mandated curriculum changes and reporting those changes to faculty. Committee members report on curriculum at their department meetings and solicit suggestions and recommendations when needed.
