Approval of March 3, 2016 Minutes

Completion Initiative

Jason Parks and Melissa Bader presented information on the completion initiative.

Peggy Campo motioned to approve the continuation of the completion initiative; Sarah Burnett seconded.

Discussion:

The completion initiative began in July of last year with a series of brown bag meetings and retreats. Through this process the college identified some basic themes: clear and directed pathways, Meta majors, faculty advisement models, linking college to career, and student ambassadors. We would like to keep the initiative going; it has been approved at ISPC and Academic Senate. We are voting to continue our planning during the summer to establish a timeline and necessary resources.

Emergency Operations Plan

Lisa McAllister and Sherry Stone presented information on the District Emergency Operations Plan.

Paul Van Hulle motioned to approve the Emergency Operations Plan; Buck Stevens seconded.

- ALL Hazard Plan
- Guides Organization and Response to Emergencies
- Guides RCCD Coordination with Other Agencies
- Captures Critical Roles/Responsibilities
- Contains Pertinent Information for Management of Emergency Events
- Annexes Provide Refinement and Other Actions to Take During Specific Emergency Types
- EOP's are Guidance Documents and Provide for Flexibility with the Incident Command System.
- Plan will be revised to include college specific action plans for Norco

Questions/concerns were raised by members on 1) active shooter barricades; 2) West End Quad cannot hear siren; 3) classroom phones and the expectation that everyone has a cell phone. A recommendation was made to hold safety training during FLEX to address questions like these.

Grad Guru App

Gustavo Oceguera presented information on the Grad Guru app.

Sarah Burnett motioned to approve piloting the Grad Guru app; Kim Kamerin seconded.

Discussion:

- How to use technology to better communication with our students.
- App does not replace how we officially communication with students.
- This app can lead students to the portal to get their information. Info on deadlines, campus events, workshops and services.

- The app features instant messages through push notifications and is free to students.
 There is no advertising, and students choose the information they want to enter so the information provided is self-reporting. Students may opt out at any time.
- Does not require IT support.
- To pilot in the fall we will need a meeting, we are ready to try it out in the fall with a test group.
- Can purchase a one year or three year agreement with a discount. Cost 22K for 1 year; inexpensive compared to other products currently available.
- Company is working on helping to identify cohorts of students, which would require using their student ID number with no other identifying information.
- Will have a full demo with Rick Herman to make sure we have full clearance.

Student Portal

Scott Tracy and Mark DeAsis presented information on RCCD's student portal.

The roll out of the student portal has been in the works for some time. The student portal will introduce the single sign on for Webadvisor, email and Datatel and Colleague. Students do not have to be on campus to access. We are currently in the implementation phase, evaluating and making changes. When the portal is launched, we will start with students first followed by faculty and staff. Key features include: the same functionality as Webadvisor; students enjoy that it has Webadvisor functions in the tabbed environment. Connects, Webadvisor, email, Datatel/Colleague and Office 365 schedule.
