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## Welcome

Welcome to the Dual Enrollment Program of Norco College. The Dual Enrollment Program provides face-to-face college instruction to students in high schools. Dual Enrollment offers courses that fulfill some general education requirements of the Associate Degree for Transfer or program certificates. The courses are within pathways such as Business, Administration of Justice, Gaming, STEM, Child Development, Health Science, and IGETC. We take a student-centered approach to our teaching, providing access and opportunity to student that might not have college in mind. The program is designed to meet our students' enthusiasm for learning with engaging, challenging instruction that mirrors the academic rigor provided in any other Norco College classroom.

## **Program Personnel**

As a member of the Dual Enrollment program, your work is supported by a team that bridges Norco College and our partnering high school districts.

At Norco College, the Director of Dual Enrollment, Dr. Maureen Sinclair, is responsible for ensuring the long-term health of the Dual Enrollment program, coordinating with the high schools, and addressing student and faculty needs. Please go to Maureen Sinclair with any questions you have about teaching at the high school sites. Students are supported on-site by an Outreach Specialist and an Educational Advisor. Off-site supports for Dual Enrollment include Admission & Records and Library Services.

At the high schools, you will interact most frequently with the high schools designated personal (School information sheets are distributed each year) and the colleges Dual Enrollment team.

## Instructor Information

### Faculty Clearance

College faculty teaching inside of the high schools are Norco College employees. (They are paid by the college, not the high school) and must check in and get an ID for the school. The process for receiving a first-time clearance involves obtaining an up-to-date TB test, and completing finger printing for some of the Districts. After these steps are complete, instructors make an appointment at the high school to obtain a high school ID and room key.

### Dress Code

You should dress professionally.

### Facility Rules

These will vary from high school to high school. If you follow Norco College's facility rule you will be fine.

### Facility Norms

In addition to formal rules, there are many informal norms that operate inside of the high schools. Some staff may describe these to you as rules; some may even lecture you if you do not follow these norms. In these situations, the appropriate response is to listen respectfully and to comply in the moment. Then, once you leave the high school, please let the Director Maureen Sinclair know so that she can clarify the purported rule with the high school administrators.

### Instructor Absence

If you need to cancel class due to instructor absence, please follow all **two steps** below.

**STEP 1:** Follow Norco College policy for class cancellations.

## **Course Information**

### **Attendance**

In the first two weeks of class, please send the names of absent or missing to Maureen Sinclair so she can contact the student. After the first few weeks, please continue to keep track of attendance – if a student misses a few classes in a row, we should follow up on this students' status in the class.

As with classes taught outside the high school, attendance policies for classes in Dual Enrollment program are within the instructor's discretion.

### **Drops**

If you receive word that a student has dropped the class, please tell that student (or tell others to get word to that student) that he *must* see his high school counselor. As dropping a class can have consequences to their high school requirements for graduation.

### **Class Breaks**

Please follow Norco College policy.

### **Schedule and Interruptions**

While teaching on the high school campuses you may encounter interruptions such as lock down or school events. Please work with the high school staff in these situations. Additionally, the high schools calendar does not always match up with the college's calendar. We follow the college's calendar and they have ensured us that they will open the campus if there is not school during the high school day. However, it is at your discretion and I encourage you to work with the high school staff/administration.

### **Textbooks and Instructional Supplies**

Textbooks and supplies are provided by the college. You **CANNOT** ask the student to purchase anything. (AB288 prevents us from asking or requiring the student to purchasing anything) This includes Scantrons, textbooks, and access codes. If there is a material need please contact Maureen Sinclair.

Dual Enrollment assignment you are agreeing to use the selected textbook that was determined by the faculty/department chair/deans.

**CAVA Dual Enrollment** student are in a special program. All courses are Online and may also contain regular Norco College students. The CAVA students are **required** to buy all textbooks and supplies for the courses.

### **Photocopies**

All printing for class should be done by Norco College. Please utilize your copy code at Norco's College Resource Center or send larger jobs to the RCCD print desk

### **Student Computer Access**

Students in the high schools have access to computers, but this access is limited. However, internet access is very limited if at all on some high school campuses.

### **Internet Access**
