 - 1. Does a staff presence make them uncomfortable? If so how can we alleviate that?

 - What percentage of foster youth enrolled vs. Attended
 - Is this only for foster youth students, this would be beneficial for other homeless students
 - Mary: Pushing Accuplacer testing
 - Koji: Help them register for classes and have a counselor to advise them
 - Align retreat with registration date
 - Would like to do another retreat during winter (Thanksgiving)
 - Only serves Norco college students (current/incoming)
 - College should be chosen based on program of study
 - Kristi: transportation is a major issue as well

- Patricia: most first time students will have their first 1-2 years
- Mary & Kristi: What about CTE opportunities
- Daniela: we do have an outreach specialist who does educate regarding the CTE programs. Can give student handbooks and CTE information to committee members before we leave.
- Koji: stresses the importance of the counselor to navigate the nuances
- Kristi: suggest a career exploration/assessment career counselor session Jethro Midget
