- Chair's Report Dr. Koji Uesugi
 - Update on California Wellness grant application
 - o Moving forward –site visit –Program officer came from the Calif Wellness Grant
 - o All 3 colleges are involved plus the foundation are involved for 180,000 for 3 years
 - o Individual colleges 20,000
 - o Questions that came up- not all students that get a certificate get degrees
 - o Maybe reduce the stipends that go to the students
 - o Hire a part-time position to take this on task on (with an expertise on this job)
 - o Provide more options for foster youth
 - o Grant can be awarded as soon as May but as late as July
 - Ask Stuart foundation to extend our existing grant beyond June



Review and approve FYSS and Phoenix Scholars Logos-

- Symbol of the phoenix- represents rising from the ashes & symbolizes strength & longevity. The design represents scholars both female & male with flames wings behind the student (there's a choice of light blue, dark blue, grey, white & burgundy, beige, brown
