 - The college and district still have a large number of students taking remote classes
 - Reached 100% enrollment goal across college for Fall 2024
 - Monica Huizar is the new full-time tenure track Counselor for EOPS and NextUp
 - Jennifer Briseño is the new Student Resource Specialist
 - Supports on & off campus foster youth/high school and dual enrolled students
 - b. Budget Updates
 - Received an increase of \$7,380 in the NextUp Allocation; Total for 24-25: \$310,597
 - JayBay Dual enrollment grant concludes December 2024. Will continue to offer support through fall'24. High School students receive a \$300 stipend at the end of the course.

- IV. Norco College/Phoenix Scholars Updates (Azadeh/Monica)**
 - a. Fall 2024 Enrollment
 - 24 Next Up students, 35 Phoenix Scholars, 4 pending new students.
 - b. Fall Events
 - Will send out a list of events. To include Friendsgiving, Holiday Party, Vision Board, Hiking and lots of team building activities
 - Hosted a one-day fall bridge event with a strong turnout of students participating
 - c. College Bound Day
 - Will host it for CNUSD students on: October 18, 2024 from 9:30 am – 1:30 pm
 - Club Hope and All Stars 10-12th graders only
 - 2 rotating groups to include a shopping day, tour, gaming, crime scene, music or science module along with lunch
 - Seeking donations of any kind

- d. Sp24 Outcomes: 9 students graduated and of the 9, 13 completed certificates and degrees and 6 transferred to 4-year universities
- e. Daniela suggested we consider and begin planning for a senior specific event at the end of April and during Priority Registration week to cater to the needs of seniors planning to attend Norco College. Daniela will work to determine dates of priority which looks like it will be during the week of May 5-9th. Jenna will work Jennifer and local high schools to gather the RCCD bound students for this trip. Details will be developed at the November meeting. Event will likely occur between 10-1pm.  - Provided (25) - \$200 Coral meal cards for fall'24 semester
- b. Full pantry with perishable and non-perishable items
- c. Received a small grant to support undocumented students by providing grocery and coral meal cards to students

- e. Works in collaboration with the County of Riverside to help foster youth apply for a supplemental voucher (Choice Voucher) similar to Section 8

 - Retention rate is 96%
