2. NSF ATE proposal – Photonics – Colleen Molko

- Applying on behalf of Photonics to the NSF, due Oct. 5th. Request came from Dr. Reece. Went to the Executive Cabinet. Peggy Campo is working with faculty to take these programs through the governance process.
- Three certificate programs will be developed.
