College Futures Foundation Grant Extension

- \$100, 000 award
- Extended through end of this fiscal year
- Large portion of the funding will be used for career pathways and special projects
- Additional funding need for subsequent fiscal years
- Have completed 9 of 18 objectives

California Guided Pathways Update

- Team worked over the summer; team included: Dr. Reece, Dr. Aycock, John Moore, Melissa Bader, Dr. Green, Quinton Bemiller and Dr. Lee
- Completed an honest self-assessment and action plan
- 1st institute is 9/17 9/19

Marketing

- Website Implementation
 - Link on the main page to the schools; temporary pages are up, but the team is still working on the redesigned layout
 - Sharepoint 2016 being used will help with the new layout, but district implementation is behind schedule
 - o The pages will be completed and on the website this semester
- "What's Your School?" Campaign
 - Last week, students were asked what their major is and then were told what school they belong to. Pictures of students were taken around campus last week; students don't yet understand the "Schools" concept.
 - o 2ft x 3ft posters have been ordered and will be posted around campus

ACTION: Ruth Leal will send out "School squares" to attach to email signatures

- Bounce back email
 - Has not been sent out yet; the new AST is in training and will send out the email as soon as possible.

ACTION: A follow-up report will be made at the October meeting.

- Welcome Day & Schools
 - While we saw less parents with students, we saw many more students asking questions

- o School tables gave the faculty a place to "land" for the day
- School table cloths didn't make it in time for Welcome Day, but they are on their way

Flex Day - School Activities

- Melissa Bader handed out a summary of the discussions of the schools and reviewed some of the main points (attached).
- Dr. Green set aside \$1000 per school this year. We will need a report of the activity and students served for a year-end report.
- Next step is working with staff to see how they fit in with the "schools"

ACTION: Develop form to request funding and report on activity (Melissa/Monica)

School Activities in 17FAL

 Arts & Humanities has begun inviting students to a meeting to find out more information about the school. A&H faculty will be advertising/inviting students (Kamerin/Dobson are the faculty leads)

ACTION: A request was made to ask if A&H would share the outline they are using with the other schools

Pathway Development Progress

- There are 18 ADT pathways developed and Lenny will work on posting the PDF's to the website
- Faculty will receiving a final opportunity to review before posting to the website

ACTION: Next goal is to create pathways for the areas of emphasis by end of September (Melissa/Erin)

College to Career Linkages

- Considering the idea of other software to give students more information on specific courses that link to careers.
- LinkedIn has new programs available that may work. A workshop will be held this month to assist students on setting up a profile. New link available for people who want to volunteer. They also offer "Secret Tips"
- How can we connect coursework to marketable skills? Need to explore in the future.
- AACC did a study recently that compared what employers want and what CC's offer/teach and found they were almost exactly the same.
- EduNav is a new online SEP tool being piloted through end of October

Faculty Advisement Model

- Flex training was well attended
- Lots of information and links available on the website (Kevin Fleming demonstrated how to find it): employees/faculty/faculty resources/faculty advisors

ACTION: School websites need to be updated to reflect faculty advisors only

Models of Student Care

- Collected 12 applications for School mentors over the summer
- Students are not meeting the requirements, specifically GPA
- Applications opened up again and are due 9/8/17
- Dr. Edwin Romero has agreed to serve as the advisor for the school mentors
- Peer mentoring programs have taken off; as of fall there are 7 programs up and running

- o First Year Experience (FYE)
- Men of color
- o PUENTE
- o Schools
- o STEM
- Student Support Services (SSS)
- o UMOJA
- Goal is to have two (2) coaches on campus teaching a 2-unit course to provide mentor training during the fall
- The ambassador program is continuing with the hope of increasing the size (currently 20 with plans to grow to 45)
