**California Guided Pathways Update**

- Last one was in September, next one is in November (college vanpool to Bakersfield)
- Drs. Aycock and Green sat in on a conference call with CCRC, a CAGP partner, to go over team self-assessments. Norco is right on track in some areas, ahead on others, and there are a few areas that need more attention. A report will come out in December and will be discussed at a future institute. Of the 20 college participants, we are ahead of the pack.

Teaching and Learning Committee has requested professional development in guided pathways. (Quinton)

**CCC Guided Pathways Application/Funding**

- Chancellor’s office also has a program with \$150M allocated statewide (Norco will receive \$874,300 over 5 years: year 1 = 25%, year 2 = 30%, year 3 = 25%, year 4 = 10%, year 5 = 10%)
  - Eight group participated in the required workshop
  - Self-assessment (different than the one completed for CAGP) due 12/23/17
  - Multi-year plan will be released and needs to be completed by March 2018
  - Funds will be received in April 2018
  - We’ve identified a need for paraprofessionals such as Educational Advisors
  - Not sure if the funds have to be spent out each year
  - Workgroup self-assessment drafts are due today
  - Due to senate and ISPC in November
  - To the BOT in December
  - Then to the State Chancellor’s office

**Completion Initiative**

- Timeline –
  - 18 ADT pathways are in the process of finalization
  - Trailheads for each school and AOE pathways will be completed by end of fall
- Webpage

- Working on a web presence for the Completion Initiative; likely will house webpage under strategic planning other committees
- Open meeting attendees, but will list regular attendees

### **Student School Lists by Semester**

- Student School lists for fall 2017 are out to school leads, counselors and department head if no school lead
- Cumulative units (degree and non-degree applicable)
- Lists include the program of study
- Communication tools attached to it? It's going to look different from school to school. When EduNAV comes on board it will be much more targeted
- Maybe 2 lists – one with just demographics and a different one with gpa's, etc
- For future data reports, will need to be able to put people in certain “buckets” to make the information manageable
- Communicating and tracking – how is this going to be done? Customer services relationship management. Using something like Salesforce, which is being used for fundraising
- Melissa will explore what the private, for-profit schools are using
- SARS works well for recording contacts, but not as a relationship tool

- Bounce back email – start soon

- Logistically can we make things happen the way we envision?
- Classroom clusters according to schools
- Rename the buildings according to the schools
- Look at where we want to be in 5 years and work backward
