- 3.1 Library Report (Norco College Librarians)
- Open House Feedback & Recommendations
 - Revise the scavenger hunt questions possibly using multiple choice options
 - Focus on the services that are offered in the Writing & Reading Center (WRC)
 - For the Learning Resource Center (LRC), ask: How do you make an appointment for FREE tutoring?
 - Stamp the forms to ensure that students visit each station and obtain the information for each resource
 - Provide better signage for each of the stations
 - Students prefer completing the questions on paper versus online via QR code
 - Have students walk all the way into the LRC (near the study rooms), so they can see the space that is available
 - Encourage faculty to bring their entire classes to the event
 - Add an online open house video quiz
 - Provide an online option for online students
 - Include an evening option for late classes
 - Move the pizza to foyer/lobby of either the LRC or Library
 - Advertise the WRC free iPad giveaway on the event flyer
 - Consider changing the name of the event to be more inclusive of all Academic Support Services

- [Read 2 Succeed](#)
 - *Fireworks Every Night* by Beth Raymer is the second fiction title being read for the Read 2 Succeed program,
 - Partnering with Phoenix Scholars, Men of Color, & Puente
 - The program has grown so much that Damon ran out of books to distribute
 - Some faculty are using this book in their classes
 - Send any recommendations for authors to Damon.
 - We cannot include a book if the author is not available to visit Norco College in person
 - The Spring 2026 book will be *Illegally Yours* by Rafael Agustin
 - Read 2 Succeed will be partnering with Dreamers, Unity Zone, Puente, and Men of Color

3.4 [Learning Resource Center Report](#) (Arezoo Marashi)

- Over the summer, the LRC Team transitioned to using SARS (Student Appointment & Reservation System) which has helped to increase collaboration (as required by the Stand of Care)
- The [LRC website](#) was updated and reorganized to include:
 - Tutoring schedules in a Google worksheet that allows for real time updates
 - Tutor application
 - Faculty recommendation form
 - Embedded Tutoring/Study Group request forms
- Tutors are trained a few times per semester. Contact [Arezoo Marashi](#) for details.
- Tutoring is currently available:
 - Monday – Thursday 9am-7pm
 - Friday 9am-4pm
 - Saturday 9am-2pm

3.5 [Writing & Reading Center Report](#) (Nicole Capps)

- Over the past three years, data shows that the need for tutoring in the WRC continues to increase
- More than 3500 students have been served and surveyed (since data collection began in 2022), and the WRC faculty and tutors have received 100% positive ratings
- The WRC gave away free a iPad at the Library & LRC Open House event
- The WRC is open 32.5 hours this semester
- The WRC only has an undetermined grant funded budget that still hasn't been institutionalized
 - Due to lack of funding, if a tutor is scheduled for in-person in WRC, they also have to be available online at the same time
 - It is challenging for writing tutors to be available in person & online simultaneously, especially during busy times
- WRC Advisory meetings will be held on Zoom from 11am-12pm on Friday, October 3 & November 21.
