- Resource guide was reviewed.
- We would like to consider how to incorporate this guide for NorcoCollege.
- Also, looking for people who can help the state to organize the statewide CCC summit.

- Pasadena City College region 8 is looking for people to help work on a LGBTQ meeting in October. They have a FB page if anyone is interested. Ammanda expressed interest in helping here.

3.2

- Cameron spoke at the Academic Senate and some faculty recommended an updated or refresher of the train the trainer" session.
- Committee decided to keep our main "train the trainer" sessions and having people who need a refresher to take those trainings again.
- We will have to make sure to have enough sessions to ensure people can attend.

- Cameron presented the committee's concerns about the Unity Zone to the Academic Senate.
- The Senate talked about writing resolution of support for the Unity Zone. We need to continue to collect data to maybe someday result in having a Pride center.
- We will have a PT student resource specialist by the Fall.
- Daniella has put in her budget requests for snacks and promotional elements for the Unity Zone.
- She is now responsible for the Unity Zone. Recommended that we collect the data to support fund requests. Use software like the one Phoenix Scholars uses. The Unity Center has a computer and hopefully the specialist will be able to collect usable data from not only in person, but online as well (Canvas shell, etc).

- Reviewed speaker series. Content was exceptional would have liked more people attend but can't be too hard on ourselves since it was our first speaker series.
- Need to have funds and time to market the event appropriately. Had a \$500 anonymous donation that helped, but didn't have the necessary time. Hopefully next time can recruit more students.
- W e w ould like to continue the series as an annual event. Suggested that maybe instead of having all the series during a single week, we can host one a month.
- Also, need to get these as approved for equity training flex credit.
- Not sure if the series will be inperson or still online. Discussed having a live stream for the event
 in the future. Might also want to receive recommendations from Prism as who to bring as a
 speaker of interest.

 out to nor-all. Raja's speaking contract allows us to use his recording until July.
- Jeff and Laura have the access to our committee's website to upload that.
