- Welcome & Introductions Monica opened the meeting at 1:34 pm
 - Protest update In a meeting with community leaders this week, it was mentioned that there are warrants out for some of the agitators at the Norco protest. Sheriff and City have been proactive, councilmember indicated support for Black Lives Matter movement. Corona Chamber Board is initiating a Racial Justice workgroup. Good to know that there are efforts going on in our community.
 - After the last meeting, Lisa spoke about a series of events organized by T3P (now Umoja) beginning in 2013 sharing pictures and providing a brief background. In 2014, the year Michael Brown was killed the group organized around the emergent discourse of BLM. Using a website that shared information on individuals killed by police the group looked at profiles from Jan 1 end of Mar, then built posters with images and bios on each. They created a questionnaire about police brutality and their relationship to it. There were several hundred

responses and perspectives. Raised a little over \$100 selling t-shirts the students made. Discussion on how and where the posters from this event can be posted, and also the push back on posting them in offices, and the CSS building because they were thought to be too provocative.

• Monica mentioned that there is an opportunity to join a Website Brainstorming session on August 14 at 2:00pm, she encouraged members to participate and provide feedback from a racial justice/equity lens. <u>Register here</u>.

- 3. Listen to learn
- 4. Share airtime
- 5. Be present in the conversation
- 6. Be open to new perspectives
- 7. Establish level of confidentiality
- Call in culture entails having a private, personal conversation with an individual who has used oppressive language or behavior in order to address the behavior without making a spectacle out of it.
- 9. Lean into discomfort and be brave
- 10. No titles, no positions
