Subsequently, a student from Norco College went onto social media with negative comments regarding the incident and was quickly disciplined and suspended. Student walk-outs today, for 17 minutes, in memory of the Florida H.S. victims. Rave Guardian mass alert test 3/11/18.

A drill should be planned 6 months or more in advance; needs college president input for active/required participation. Discussed having Nextel walkie talkies in each class, in place of phones.
